- **However, they became disobedient and rebelled against you and kept casting your Law behind their back, and your own prophets they killed, who bore witness against them to bring them back to you, and they went on committing acts of great disrespect. (Nehemiah 9:26)**
- **Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth, for Yehowah himself has spoken; Sons I have brought up and raised, but they themselves have revolted against me. (Isaiah 1:2)**
- **We have sinned and done wrong and acted wickedly and rebelled, and there has been a turning aside from your commandments and from your judicial decisions. (Daniel 9:5)**
- **And also for the innocent blood that he had shed, so that he filled Jerusalem with innocent blood, and Yehowah did not consent to grant forgiveness. (2 Kings 24:4)**
- **There was loose conduct in your uncleanness. For that reason I had to cleanse you, but you did not become clean from your uncleanness. You will become clean no more until I cause my rage to come to its rest in your case. (Ezekiel 24:13)**
- **And he proceeded to carry out his words that he had spoken against us and against our judges who judged us, by bringing upon us great calamity, such as was not done under the whole heavens as what has been done in Jerusalem. (Daniel 9:12)**
- **For they had behaved rebelliously against the sayings of God, and the counsel of the Most High they had disrespected. (Psalms 107:11)**
- **O Yehowah, to us belongs the shame of face, to our kings, to our princes and to our forefathers, because we have sinned against you. (Daniel 9:8)**
