[19] - References:

- And **Yehowah** God proceeded to form the man out of dust from the ground and to blow into his **nostrils** the breath of life, and the man came to be a living soul. (**Genesis 2:7**)
- I **have** found David my servant, with my holy oil I **have anointed** him. (**Psalms 89:20**)
- And King Zedekiah the son of Josiah began to reign in place of Coniah the son of Jehoiakim, whom Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon made king in the land of Judah. (**Jeremiah 37:1**)
- Then they seized the king and brought him up to the king of Babylon at Riblah, that they might pronounce a judicial decision upon him. (**2 Kings 25:6**)
- And a military force of the Chaldeans went chasing after them, and they got to overtake Zedekiah in the desert plains of Jericho. Then they took him and brought him up to Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon at Riblah in the land of Hamath that he might pronounce upon him judicial decisions. (**Jeremiah 39:5**)
- And a military force of the Chaldeans went chasing after the king, and they got to overtake Zedekiah in the desert plains of Jericho, and all his own military force was scattered from his side. (**Jeremiah 52:8**)
- And I shall certainly spread my net over him, and he must be caught in my hunting net, and I will bring him to Babylon, to the land of the Chaldeans, but it he will not see, and there he will die. (**Ezekiel 12:13**)
- At this the bramble **said** to the trees; If it is in truth that **you** are anointing me as king over **you**, come, seek refuge under my

- shadow. But if not, let fire come out of the bramble and consume the cedars of Lebanon. (**Judges 9:15**)
- Its foliage was fair, and its fruit was abundant, and there was food for all on it. Under it the beast of the field would seek **shade**, and on its boughs the birds of the heavens would dwell, and from it all flesh would feed itself. (**Daniel 4:12**)
 - Tomorrow about this time I shall send to you a man from the land of Benjamin, and you must anoint him as leader over my people Israel, and he must save my people from the hand of the Philistines, because I **have** seen the affliction of my people, for their outcry **has** come to me. (**1 Samuel 9:16**)
 - But the people **said**; You must not go out, for if we should at all flee, they would not set heart upon us, and if half of us would die, they would not set heart upon us, because you are worth ten thousand of us, and now it would be better if you would be of service to us to give help from the city. (**2 Samuel 18:3**)
 - And Jeremiah began to chant over Josiah, and all the male singers and female singers keep talking about Josiah in their dirges down till today, and they **have** them set as a regulation over Israel, and there they are written **among** the dirges. (**2 Chronicles 35:25**)
 - In peace you will die, and as with the burnings for your fathers, the former kings who happened to be prior to you, so they will make a burning for you, and Alas, O master! Is what they will say in lament for you, for I myself **have** spoken the very word, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 34:5**)
 - And Zedekiah the king of Judah and his princes I shall give into the hand of their enemies and into the hand of those seeking for their soul and into the hand of the military forces of the king of Babylon who are withdrawing from against **you** men. (**Jeremiah 34:21**)
 - Her gates **have** sunk down into the very earth. He **has** destroyed and broken her bars in pieces. Her king and her princes are **among** the nations. There is no Law. Her own prophets also **have** found no vision from **Yehowah**. (**Lamentations 2:9**)
 - And nations all around from the jurisdictional districts began to set against him and got to spread over him their net. In their **pit** he was caught. (**Ezekiel 19:8**)

- **And fire proceeded to come forth from her rod. It devoured her very shoots, her very fruit, and there proved to be in her no strong rod, no scepter for ruling. That is a dirge, and it will become a dirge. (Ezekiel 19:14)**
- **With him they themselves also **have** gone down to Sheol, to those slain by the sword, and those who as his seed **have** dwelt in his shadow in the midst of nations. (Ezekiel 31:17)**
- **But all this **has** taken place for the scriptures of the prophets to be fulfilled. Then all the disciples abandoned him and fled. (Matthew 26:56)**
