

**Lamentations 4:8** Their aspect has become darker than blackness itself. They have not been recognized in the streets. Their skin has shriveled upon their bones. It has become just as dry as a tree.

[6] - References:

- When they raised their eyes from far off they did not then recognize him. And they proceeded to raise their voice and weep and rip each one his sleeveless coat apart and toss dust toward the heavens upon their heads. (**Job 2:12**)
- To my **skin** and to my flesh my **bones** actually cleave, and I escape with the **skin** of my teeth. (**Job 19:20**)
- Because of the sound of my sighing my **bones** have stuck to my flesh. (**Psalms 102:5**)
- My very **skin** became black and dropped off me, and my very **bones** became hot from dryness. (**Job 30:30**)
- Our very **skin** has grown hot **just** like a furnace, because of the pangs of hunger. (**Lamentations 5:10**)
