• And he carried me away in the power of the spirit into a wilderness. And I caught sight of a woman sitting upon a scarlet-colored wild beast that was full of blasphemous names and that had seven heads and ten horns. **(Revelation 17:3)**

• Neither be called leaders, for **YOUR** Leader is one, the Christ. **(Matthew 23:10)**

• But the greatest one among **YOU** must be **YOUR** minister. **(Matthew 23:11)**

• Whoever exalts himself **will** be humbled, and whoever humbles himself **will** be exalted. **(Matthew 23:12)**

• For this is what **Yehowah** has said; Here I am extending to her **peace** just like a river and the glory of nations just like a flooding torrent, and **you will** certainly suck. Upon the flank **you will** be carried, and upon the knees **you will** be fondled. **(Isaiah 66:12)**

- Turn back at my reproof. Then to **you** I **will** cause my spirit to bubble forth, I **will** make my words known to **you**. (**Proverbs 1:23**)
- Because length of days and years of life and **peace will** be added to you. (**Proverbs 3:2**)
- And many peoples **will** certainly go and say; Come, **you** people, and let us go up to the mountain of **Yehowah**, to the house of the God of Jacob, and he **will** instruct us about his ways, and we **will** walk in his paths.
