- The rod of your strength Yehowah **will** send out of Zion, saying; Go subduing in the midst of your enemies. (Psalms 110:2)
- And many **peoples will** certainly go and say; Come, **you** people, and let us go up to the mountain of Yehowah, to the house of the God of Jacob, and he **will** instruct us about his ways, and we **will** walk in his paths. For out of Zion Law **will** go forth, and the word of Yehowah out of Jerusalem. (Isaiah 2:3)
- And a certain ruler questioned him, saying; Good Teacher, by doing what shall I inherit everlasting life? (Luke 18:18)
- Jesus said to him; Why do you call me good? Nobody is good, except one, God. (Luke 18:19)
- Every good gift and every perfect present is from above, for it comes down from the Father of the celestial lights, and with him there is not a variation of the turning of the shadow. (James 1:17)
- Until the Ancient of Days came and judgment itself was given in favor of the holy ones of the Supreme One, and the definite time arrived that the holy ones took **possession** of the kingdom itself. (Daniel 7:22)
- For when he sees his children, the **work** of my **hands**, in the midst of him, they **will** sanctify my name, and they **will** certainly sanctify the Holy One of Jacob, and the God of Israel they **will** regard with awe. (Isaiah 29:23)

- And in the wilderness justice **will** certainly reside, and in the orchard righteousness itself **will** dwell. (**Isaiah 32:16**)
- Everyone that is called by my name and that I have created for my own glory, that I have formed, yes, that I have made. (**Isaiah 43:7**)
- The people whom I have formed for myself, that they should recount the praise of me. (**Isaiah 43:21**)
- Joyfully cry out, **you** heavens, for Yehowah has taken action! Shout in triumph, all **you** lowest parts of the earth! Become cheerful, **you** mountains, with joyful outcry, you forest and all **you** trees in it! For Yehowah has repurchased Jacob, and on Israel he shows his beauty. (**Isaiah 44:23**)
- But the meek ones themselves **will** possess the earth, and they **will** indeed find their exquisite delight in the abundance of peace. (**Psalms 37:11**)
- The **righteous** themselves **will** possess the earth, and they **will** reside forever upon it. (**Psalms 37:29**)
- Those who are planted in the house of Yehowah, in the courtyards of our God, they **will** blossom forth. (**Psalms 92:13**)
- But there are new heavens and a new earth that we are awaiting according to his promise, and in these righteousness is to dwell. (**2 Peter 3:13**)
- Happy are the mild-tempered ones, since they **will** inherit the earth. (**Matthew 5:5**)
- Anyone conquering **will** inherit these things, and I shall be his God and he **will** be my son. (**Revelation 21:7**)
- In reply he said; Every plant that my heavenly Father did not plant **will** be uprooted. (**Matthew 15:13**)
- For we are a product of his **work** and were created in union with Christ Jesus for good **works**, which God prepared in advance for us to walk in them. (**Ephesians 2:10**)
- The one trusting in his riches, he himself **will** fall, but just like foliage the **righteous** ones **will** flourish. (**Proverbs 11:28**)
- In that day what Yehowah makes **sprout will** come to be for decoration and for glory, and the fruitage of the **land will** be something to be proud of and something beautiful for those of Israel who have escaped. (**Isaiah 4:2**)

- And it must occur that the ones remaining in Zion and the ones left over in Jerusalem **will** be said to be holy to him, everyone written down for life in Jerusalem. (**Isaiah 4:3**)
- You have added to the nation, O Yehowah, you have added to the nation, you have glorified yourself. You have extended afar all the borders of the **land**. (**Isaiah 26:15**)
- In the wilderness I shall set the cedar tree, the acacia and the myrtle and the oil tree. In the desert plain I shall place the juniper tree, the ash and the cypress at the same time. (**Isaiah 41:19**)
- The people whom I have formed for myself, that they should recount the praise of me. (**Isaiah 43:21**)
- This is what Yehowah has said, the Holy One of Israel and the Former of him; Ask me even about the things that are coming concerning my sons, and concerning the activity of my **hands** **you** people should command me. (**Isaiah 45:11**)
- I have brought near my righteousness. It is not far away, and my own salvation **will** not be late. And I **will** give in Zion salvation, to Israel my beauty. (**Isaiah 46:13**)
- Wake up, wake up, put on your strength, O Zion! Put on your beautiful garments, O Jerusalem, the holy city! For no more **will** there come again into you the uncircumcised and unclean one. (**Isaiah 52:1**)
- You **will** prove to be firmly established in righteousness itself. You **will** be far away from oppression, for you **will** fear none, and from anything terrifying, for it **will** not come near you. (**Isaiah 54:14**)
- To assign to those mourning over Zion, to give them a headdress instead of ashes, the oil of exultation instead of mourning, the mantle of praise instead of the downhearted spirit, and they must be called big trees of righteousness, the **planting** of Yehowah, for him to be **beautified**. (**Isaiah 61:3**)
- And I **will** bring forth out of Jacob an offspring and out of Judah the hereditary possessor of my mountains, and my chosen ones must take **possession** of it, and my own servants **will** reside there. (**Isaiah 65:9**)
- And upon **you** I **will** cause humankind to walk, even my people Israel, and they must take **possession** of **you**, and **you** must become a hereditary **possession** to them, and **you will** not bereave them again of any more children. (**Ezekiel 36:12**)

- And they **will** actually dwell upon the **land** that I gave to my servant, to Jacob, in which **YOUR** forefathers dwelt, and they **will** actually dwell upon it, they and their sons and their sons' sons to time **indefinite**, and David my servant **will** be their chieftain to time **indefinite**. (**Ezekiel 37:25**)

- As regards the remaining ones of Israel, they **will** do no unrighteousness, nor speak a lie, nor **will** there be found in their mouths a tricky tongue, for they themselves **will** feed and actually lie stretched out, and there **will** be no one making them tremble. (**Zephaniah 3:13**)
