Psalms 27:9· Do not conceal your face from me. Do not in anger turn your servant away. My assistance you must become. Do not forsake me and do not leave me, O my God of salvation.

- The war chariots of **God** are in tens of thousands, thousands over and over again. Yehowah himself has come from Sinai into the holy place. (**Psalms 68:17**)
- O hurry, answer me, O Yehowah. My spirit has come to an end. Do not conceal your **face** from me, or else I **must become** comparable with those going down into the pit. (**Psalms 143:7**)
- No, but the very errors of **YOU** people have **become** the things causing division between **YOU** and **YOUR God**, and **YOUR** own sins have caused the concealing of his **face** from **YOU** to keep from hearing. (**Isaiah 59:2**)
- This is what Yehowah has said; Where, then, is the divorce certificate of the mother of **YOU** people, whom I sent **away**? Or which one of my creditors is it to whom I have sold **YOU** people? Look! Because of **YOUR** own errors **YOU** have been sold, and because of **YOUR** own transgressions **YOUR** mother has been sent **away**. (**Isaiah 50:1**)
- Then Samuel took a stone and set it between Mizpah and Jeshanah and began to call its name Ebenezer. Accordingly he said; Till now Yehowah has helped us. (**1 Samuel 7:12**)
- **God** is for us a refuge and strength, a help that is readily to be found during distresses. (**Psalms 46:1**)
- Do not **leave** me, O Yehowah. O my **God**, do not keep far **away** from me. (**Psalms 38:21**)

- O Yehowah, the **God** of my **salvation**, by day I have cried out, in the night also in front of you. (**Psalms 88:1**)
- At that my **anger** will indeed blaze against them in that day, and I shall certainly **forsake** them and conceal my **face** from them, and they **must become** something to be consumed, and many calamities and distresses **must** come upon them, and they will be bound to say in that day, Is it not because our **God** is not in our midst that these calamities have come upon us? (**Deuteronomy 31:17**)
- When he himself causes quietness, who, then, can condemn? And when he **conceals** his **face**, who can behold him, whether it is toward a nation or toward a man, it being the same thing? (**Job 34:29**)
- And do not conceal your **face** from your **servant**. Because I am in sore straits, answer me quickly. (**Psalms 69:17**)
- Do not conceal your **face** from me on the day that I am in sore straits. Incline to me your ear, on the day that I call, hurry, answer me. (**Psalms 102:2**)
