- I shall laud you in uprightness of heart, when I learn your righteous judicial decisions. (Psalms 119:7)
- On this account cease becoming unreasonable, but go on perceiving what the will of Yehowah is. (Ephesians 5:17)
- Then God said once more to Moses; This is what you are to say to the sons of Israel, Yehowah the God of YOUR forefathers, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob, has sent me to YOU. This is my name to time indefinite, and this is the memorial of me to generation after generation. (Exodus 3:15)
- O Yehowah, your name is to time indefinite. O Yehowah, your memorial is to generation after generation. (Psalms 135:13)
- And Yehowah the God of the armies, Yehowah is his memorial. (Hosea 12:5)
- But as for me, it is for Yehowah that I shall keep on the lookout. I will show a waiting attitude for the God of my salvation. My God will hear me. (Micah 7:7)
- Ah, Yehowah, please, let your ear become attentive to the prayer of your servant and to the prayer of your servants who take delight in fearing your name, and, please, do grant success to your servant today and make him an object of pity before this man. Now I myself happened to be cupbearer to the king. (Nehemiah 1:11)
- As the hind that longs for the water streams, so my very soul longs for you, O God. (Psalms 42:1)

- **I have hoped, O Yehowah, my soul has hoped, and for his word I have waited. (Psalms 130:5)**
- **In that time they will call Jerusalem the throne of Yehowah, and to her all the nations must be brought together to the name of Yehowah at Jerusalem, and they will no more walk after the stubbornness of their bad heart. (Jeremiah 3:17)**
