- Yehowah of armies, he is the **One** whom **you** should treat as holy, and he should be the object of **your** fear, and he should be the **One** causing **you** to tremble. (**Isaiah 8:13**)
- And Yehowah of armies **will** become high through judgment, and the true **God**, the **Holy One**, **will certainly sanctify** himself through righteousness. (**Isaiah 5:16**)
- The people whom I have formed for myself, that they should recount the praise of me. (**Isaiah 43:21**)
- This is what Yehowah has said, the **Holy One** of **Israel** and the Former of him; Ask me even about the things that are coming concerning my sons, and concerning the activity of my **hands you** people should command me. (**Isaiah 45:11**)
- Then Moses said to Aaron; This is what Yehowah has spoken, saying; Among those near to me let me be sanctified, and before the face of all the people let me be glorified. And Aaron kept silent. (**Leviticus 10:3**)
- And **you** must not profane my holy **name**, and I must be sanctified in the **midst** of the sons of **Israel**. I am Yehowah who is sanctifying **you**. (**Leviticus 22:32**)
- **You** must pray, then, this way; Our Father in the heavens, let your **name** be sanctified. (**Matthew 6:9**)

- Afterwards the sons of **Israel will** come back and **certainly** look for Yehowah their **God**, and for David their king, and they **will certainly** come quivering to Yehowah and to his goodness in the final part of the days. (**Hosea 3:5**)
- Who **will** not really fear you, Yehowah, and glorify your **name**, because you alone are loyal? For all the nations **will** come and worship before you, because your righteous decrees have been made manifest. (**Revelation 15:4**)
- Also, a voice issued forth from the throne and said; Be praising our **God**, all **you** his slaves, who fear him, the small ones and the great. (**Revelation 19:5**)
- If you **will** not take care to carry out all the words of this Law that are written in this book so as to fear this glorious and fear-inspiring **name**, even Yehowah, your **God**. (**Deuteronomy 28:58**)
