- And David became **afraid** of Yehowah on that day and began to say; How will the ark of Yehowah come to me? (**2 Samuel 6:9**)
- Serve Yehowah with fear and be joyful with trembling. (**Psalms 2:11**)
- I heard, and my belly began to be agitated, at the sound my lips quivered, rottenness began to enter into my bones, and in my situation I was agitated, that I should quietly wait for the day of distress, for his coming up to the people, that he may raid them. (**Habakkuk 3:16**)
- And **you** people must keep all my statutes and all my **judicial decisions** and do them, that the land to which I am bringing **you** to dwell in it may not vomit **you** out. (**Leviticus 20:22**)
- They were adhering to their brothers, their majestic ones, and coming into liability to a curse and into an oath, to walk in the Law of the true God, which had been given by the hand of Moses the servant of the true God, and to keep and to perform all the commandments of Yehowah our Lord and his **judicial decisions** and his regulations. (**Nehemiah 10:29**)
- And David had not been able to go before it to consult God, for he had been terrified because of the sword of Yehowah's angel. (**1 Chronicles 21:30**)
- And he kept doing what was right in Yehowah's eyes, according to all that Uzziah his father had done. Only he did not invade the temple of Yehowah. However, the people were yet acting ruinously. (**2 Chronicles 27:2**)

- And it came about that as soon as the king heard the words of the Law, he immediately ripped his garments apart. (**2 Chronicles 34:19**)
- Put your own hand far away from upon me, and the fright of you, may it not terrify me. (**Job 13:21**)
- That is why I feel disturbed because of him, I show myself attentive and am in dread of him. (**Job 23:15**)
- And the righteous ones will see it and will be **afraid**, and over him they will laugh. (**Psalms 52:6**)
- Fear, yes, trembling itself enters into me, and shuddering covers me. (**Psalms 55:5**)
- Enter into the rock and hide yourself in the dust because of the dreadfulness of Yehowah, and from his splendid superiority. (**Isaiah 2:10**)
- In order to enter into the holes in the rocks and into the clefts of the crags, because of the dreadfulness of Yehowah and from his splendid superiority, when he rises up for the earth to suffer shocks. (**Isaiah 2:21**)
- Do **you** not fear even me, is the utterance of Yehowah, or are **you** in no severe pains even because of me, who **have** set the sand as the boundary for the sea, an indefinitely lasting regulation that it cannot pass over? Although its waves toss themselves, still they cannot prevail, and although they do become boisterous, still they cannot pass over it. (**Jeremiah 5:22**)
- And it came about that as soon as I prophesied Pelatiah the son of Benaiah himself died, and I proceeded to fall upon my face and cry with a loud voice and say; Alas, O Sovereign Lord Yehowah! Is it an extermination that you are executing with the remaining ones of Israel? (**Ezekiel 11:13**)
- But I will indicate to **you** whom to fear; Fear him who after killing **has** authority to throw into Gehenna. Yes, I tell **you**, fear this One. (**Luke 12:5**)
