- He has redeemed my **soul** from passing into the pit, and my life itself **will** see the light. (**Job 33:28**)
- For you **will** not leave my **soul** in **Sheol**. You **will** not allow your loyal one to see the pit. (**Psalms 16:10**)
- O Yehowah, you have brought up my **soul** from **Sheol** itself, you have kept me alive, that I should not go down into the pit. (**Psalms 30:3**)
- For you have delivered my **soul** from death. Have you not delivered my feet from stumbling? That I may walk about before God in the light of those alive. (**Psalms 56:13**)
- For your loving-kindness is great toward me, and you have delivered my **soul** out of **Sheol**, its lowest place. (**Psalms 86:13**)
- Yehowah is a Killer and a Preserver of life, a Bringer down to **Sheol**, and He brings up. (**1 Samuel 2:6**)
- What able-bodied man is there alive who **will** not see death? Can he provide escape for his **soul** from the **hand** of **Sheol**? (**Psalms 89:48**)
- He proceeded to send his word and heal them and to provide them escape out of their pits. (**Psalms 107:20**)
- The one stooping in chains **will** certainly be loosened speedily, that he may not go in death to the pit and that his bread may not be lacking. (**Isaiah 51:14**)
- From the **hand** of **Sheol** I shall **redeem** them, from death I shall recover them. Where are your stings, O Death? Where is your

destructiveness, O **Sheol**? Compassion itself **will** be concealed from my eyes. (**Hosea 13:14**)
