- For Yehowah your **God** is walking about within your camp to deliver you and to abandon your enemies to you, and your camp must prove to be holy, that he may see nothing indecent in you and certainly turn away from accompanying you. (**Deuteronomy 23:14**)
- For Yehowah has chosen Zion, he has longed for it as a dwelling for himself. (**Psalms 132:13**)
- Cry out shrilly and shout for joy, O you inhabitress of Zion, for great in the **midst** of you is the Holy One of Israel. (**Isaiah 12:6**)
- I shall not express my burning anger. I shall not bring Ephraim to ruin again, for I am **God** and not man, the Holy One in the **midst** of you, and I shall not come in excitement. (**Hosea 11:9**)
- Wherefore, seeing that we are to receive a kingdom that cannot be shaken, let us continue to have undeserved kindness, through which we may acceptably render **God** sacred service with godly fear and awe. (**Hebrews 12:28**)
- And it came about during the **morning** watch that Yehowah began to look out upon the camp of the Egyptians from within the pillar of fire and cloud, and he went throwing the camp of the Egyptians into confusion. (**Exodus 14:24**)
- Because being under his anger is for a moment, being under his goodwill is for a lifetime. In the evening weeping may take up lodging, but in the **morning** there is a joyful cry. (**Psalms 30:5**)
- In the **morning** cause me to hear your loving-kindness, for in you I have put my trust. Make known to me the way in which I should walk, for to you I have lifted up my soul. (**Psalms 143:8**)

- You must not suffer a shock because of them, for Yehowah your **God** is in your **midst**, a great and fear-inspiring **God**. (**Deuteronomy 7:21**)
- This is my resting-place forever, here I shall dwell, for I have longed for it. (**Psalms 132:14**)
- Behold Zion, the town of our festal occasions! Your own eyes **will** see Jerusalem an undisturbed abiding place, a tent that no one **will** pack up. Never **will** its tent pins be pulled out, and none of its ropes **will** be torn in two. (**Isaiah 33:20**)
- My righteousness is near. My salvation **will** certainly go forth, and my own arms **will** judge even the peoples. In me the islands themselves **will** hope, and for my arm they **will** wait. (**Isaiah 51:5**)
- Why do you become like a man astounded, like a mighty man that is unable to do any saving? Yet you yourself are in the **midst** of us, O Yehowah, and upon us it is that your own name has been called. Do not let us down. (**Jeremiah 14:9**)
- And **you** people **will** have to know that I am in the **midst** of Israel, and that I am Yehowah **YOUR God** and there is no other. And my people **will** not be ashamed to time indefinite. (**Joel 2:27**)
- Cry out loudly and rejoice, O daughter of Zion, for here I am coming, and I **will** reside in the **midst** of you, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Zechariah 2:10**)
