- O Yehowah, who **will** be a guest in your tent? Who **will reside** in your **holy** mountain? (**Psalms 15:1**)
- For Yah has chosen even Jacob for himself, Israel for his special property. (**Psalms 135:4**)
- One thing I have asked from Yehowah, It is what I shall look for, that I may dwell in the **house** of Yehowah all the days of my life, to behold the pleasantness of Yehowah and to look with appreciation upon his **temple**. (**Psalms 27:4**)
- Happy are those dwelling in your **house**! They still keep on praising you. (**Psalms 84:4**)
- For a day in your **courtyards** is better than a thousand elsewhere. I have chosen to stand at the threshold in the **house** of my God rather than to move around in the tents of wickedness. (**Psalms 84:10**)
- They drink their fill of the fatness of your **house**, and of the torrent of your pleasures you cause them to drink. (**Psalms 36:8**)
- As with the best part, even fatness, my soul is **satisfied**, and with lips of joyful cries my mouth offers praise. (**Psalms 63:5**)
- And the lamp of God was not yet extinguished, and Samuel was lying in the **temple** of Yehowah, where the ark of God was. (**1 Samuel 3:3**)
- Thus they brought the ark of the true God in and placed it inside the tent that David had pitched for it, and they began to present burnt

offerings and communion sacrifices before the true God. (**1 Chronicles 16:1**)

· Later Saul said; Let us go down after the Philistines by night and plunder them until the morning lightens up, and let us not leave a single one among them. To this they said; Anything that is good in your eyes do. Then the priest said; Let us **approach** here to the true God. (**1 Samuel 14:36**)
