He must also appear with rejoicing on **YOUR** part, and they are the ones that will be put to shame.

- For it is contained in Scripture; Look! I am laying in Zion a stone, chosen, a foundation cornerstone, precious, and no one exercising faith in it **will** by any means come to disappointment. (1 Peter 2:6)
- It is to **YOU**, therefore, that he is precious, because **YOU** are believers, but to those not believing, the identical stone that the builders rejected has become the head of the corner. (1 Peter 2:7)

- And now let us conclude a covenant with our God to **put** away all the wives and those born from them according to the counsel of **Yehowah** and of those **trembling** at the commandment of our God, that it may be done according to the Law. (Ezra 10:3)
- Now all these things my own hand has made, so that all these came to be, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. To this one, then, I shall

look, to the one afflicted and contrite in spirit and **trembling** at my **word**. (**Isaiah 66:2**)

- Now it came about that as soon as they heard all the **words**, they looked at one another in dread, and they proceeded to say to Baruch; We shall without fail tell the king all these words. (**Jeremiah 36:16**)

- Men **will** expel **you** from the synagogue. In fact, the hour is coming when everyone that kills **you will** imagine he has rendered a sacred service to God. (**John 16:2**)

- But because of the false **brothers** brought in quietly, who sneaked in to spy upon our freedom which we have in union with Christ Jesus, that they might completely enslave us. (**Galatians 2:4**)

- Let no one seduce **you** in any manner, because it **will** not come unless the apostasy comes first and the man of Lawlessness gets revealed, the son of destruction. (**2 Thessalonians 2:3**)

- They blaspheme the fine **name** by which **you** were called, do they not? (**James 2:7**)

- Those who are saying; Let his work hasten, do let it come quickly, in order, that we may see it, and let the counsel of the Holy One of Israel draw near and come, that we may know it! (**Isaiah 5:19**)

- And **Yehowah** says; For the **reason** that this people have come near with their mouth, and they have glorified me merely with their lips, and they have removed their heart itself far away from me, and their fear toward me becomes men's commandment that is being taught. (**Isaiah 29:13**)

- Therefore here I am, the One that **will** act wonderfully again with this people, in a wonderful manner and with something wonderful, and the wisdom of their wise **men must** perish, and the very understanding of their discreet **men will** conceal itself. (**Isaiah 29:14**)

- And to you the sons of those afflicting you **must** go, bowing down, and all those treating you disrespectfully **must** bend down at the very soles of your feet, and they **will** have to call you the city of **Yehowah**, Zion of the Holy One of Israel. (**Isaiah 60:14**)

- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** has **said**; Look! My own servants **will** eat, but **you** yourselves **will** go hungry. Look! My own servants **will** drink, but **you** yourselves **will** go thirsty. Look! My own servants **will** rejoice, but **you** yourselves **will** suffer shame. (**Isaiah 65:13**)
- Look! My own servants **will** cry out joyfully because of the good condition of the heart, but **you** yourselves **will** make outcries because of the pain of heart and **you will** howl because of sheer breakdown of spirit. (**Isaiah 65:14**)
- O **Yehowah**, the hope of Israel, all those who are leaving you **will** be **put** to shame. Those apostatizing from me **will** be written down even in the earth, because they have left the source of living water, **Yehowah**. (**Jeremiah 17:13**)
- Let my persecutors be **put** to shame, but let me personally be **put** to no shame. Let them be the **ones** to be struck with terror, but let me personally not be struck with terror. Bring upon them the day of calamity, and break them even with twice as much breakdown. (**Jeremiah 17:18**)
- But as for me, I **said**; It is for nothing that I have toiled. For unreality and vanity I have used up my own power. Truly my judgment is with **Yehowah**, and my wages with my God. (**Isaiah 49:4**)
- Son of man, as regards your **brothers**, your **brothers**, the **men** concerned with your right to repurchase, and all the house of Israel, all of it, are the **ones** to whom the inhabitants of Jerusalem have **said**; Get far away from **Yehowah**.
