Psalms 13:1· How long, O Yehowah, will you forget me? Forever? How long will you conceal your face from me?

- Yes, my own soul has been very much disturbed, and you O Yehowah, how long? (**Psalms 6:3**)
- Why is it, O Yehowah, that you cast off my soul? Why do you keep your **face** concealed from me? (**Psalms 88:14**)
- No, but the very errors of **YOU** people have become the things causing division between **YOU** and **YOUR** God, and **YOUR** own sins have caused the concealing of his **face** from **YOU** to keep from hearing. (**Isaiah 59:2**)
- Why is it that forever you **forget** us, that you leave us for the length of days? (**Lamentations 5:20**)
- At that my anger **will** indeed blaze against them in that day, and I shall certainly forsake them and **conceal** my **face** from them, and they must become something to be consumed, and many calamities and distresses must come upon them, and they **will** be bound to say in that day, Is it not because our God is not in our midst that these calamities have come upon us? (**Deuteronomy 31:17**)
- Why do you **conceal** your very **face** and regard me as an enemy of yours? (**Job 13:24**)
- O my God, I keep calling by day, and you do not answer, and by night, and there is no silence on my part. (**Psalms 22:2**)
- No, but the very errors of **YOU** people have become the things causing division between **YOU** and **YOUR** God, and **YOUR** own sins have caused the concealing of his **face** from **YOU** to keep from hearing. (**Isaiah 59:2**)
- Why, O Yehowah, do you keep standing afar off? Why do you keep yourself hid in times of distress? (**Psalms 10:1**)

- I **will** say to God my crag; Why have you forgotten me? Why do I walk sad because of the oppression of the enemy? (**Psalms 42:9**)
- Do arouse yourself. Why do you keep sleeping, O Yehowah? Do awake. Do not keep casting off forever. (**Psalms 44:23**)
- How long, O Yehowah, **will** you keep yourself concealed? For all time? Will your rage keep on burning just like a fire? (**Psalms 89:46**)
- Do not **conceal** your **face** from me on the day that I am in sore straits. Incline to me your ear, on the day that I call, hurry, answer me. (**Psalms 102:2**)
- But Zion kept saying; Yehowah has left me, and Yehowah himself has forgotten me. (**Isaiah 49:14**)
- How long, O Yehowah, must I cry for help, and you do not hear? How long shall I call to you for aid from violence, and you do not save? (**Habakkuk 1:2**)
