- These things I will remember, and I will pour out my soul within me. For I used to pass along with the throng, I used to walk slowly before them to the **house** of God, with the voice of a joyful cry and thanksgiving, of a crowd celebrating a festival. (**Psalms 42:4**)
- Because we used to enjoy sweet intimacy together, into the **house** of God we used to walk with the throng. (**Psalms 55:14**)
- That I may see the goodness to your chosen ones, that I may rejoice with the rejoicing of your nation, that I may make my boast with your inheritance. (**Psalms 106:5**)
- One thing I have asked from Yehowah, it is what I shall look for; That I may dwell in the **house** of **Yehowah** all the days of my life, to behold the pleasantness of **Yehowah** and to look with appreciation upon his temple. (**Psalms 27:4**)
- And David and all the **house** of Israel were bringing up the ark of **Yehowah** with joyful shouting and sound of horn. (**2 Samuel 6:15**)
- For a day in your courtyards is better than a thousand elsewhere. I have chosen to stand at the threshold in the **house** of my God rather than to move around in the tents of wickedness. (**Psalms 84:10**)
