

ANOINTED - I SHALL COME INTO YOUR HOUSE, TO YOU

~ **Messianic** ... **Prophecy** ... **Anointed** - I shall come into your house, to you I shall pay my vows' (**Psalms 66:13**) [14] - References

Psalms 66:13· I shall come into your house with whole burnt offerings, I shall pay to you my vows

[14] - References

- And **YOU** must render up an offering made by fire to Yehowah, a **burnt** offering or a sacrifice to perform a special vow or voluntarily or during **YOUR** seasonal festivals, in order to make a restful odor to Yehowah, from the herd or from the flock. (**Numbers 15:3**)
- Come into his gates with thanksgiving, into his courtyards with praise. Give thanks to him, bless his name. (**Psalms 100:4**)
- From you my praise will be in the large congregation, my **vows** I shall **pay** in front of those fearing him. (**Psalms 22:25**)
- Upon me, O God, there are **vows** to you. I shall render expressions of thanksgiving to you. (**Psalms 56:12**)
- My **vows** I shall **pay** to Yehowah, yes, in front of all his people. (**Psalms 116:14**)
- Whenever you vow a vow to God, do not hesitate to **pay** it, for there is no delight in the stupid ones. What you vow, **pay**. (**Ecclesiastes 5:4**)
- And if the sacrifice of his offering is a vow or a voluntary offering, it is to be eaten on the day of his presenting his sacrifice, and on the next day what is left of it also may be eaten. (**Leviticus 7:16**)
- In case a man makes a vow to Yehowah or swears an oath to bind a vow of abstinence upon his soul, he must not violate his word. According to all that has gone out of his mouth he should do. (**Numbers 30:2**)
- In case you vow a vow to Yehowah your God, you must not be slow about paying it, because Yehowah your God will without fail require it of you, and it would indeed become a sin on your part. (**Deuteronomy 23:21**)

- It must also occur that the one coming out, who **comes** out of the doors of my **house** to meet me when I return in peace from the sons of Ammon, must also become Yehowahs, and I must offer that one up as a **burnt** offering. (**Judges 11:31**)
- Now one of Saul's servants was there on that day, detained before Yehowah, and his name was Doeg the Edomite, the principal one of the shepherds that belonged to Saul. (**1 Samuel 21:7**)
- Go back, and you must say to Hezekiah the leader of my people, This is what Yehowah the God of David your forefather has said; I have heard your prayer. I have seen your tears. Here I am healing you. On the third day you will go up to the **house** of Yehowah. (**2 Kings 20:5**)
- So I will make melody to your name forever, that I may **pay** my **vows** day after day. (**Psalms 61:8**)
- I have made a sworn statement, and I will carry it out, to keep your righteous judicial decisions. (**Psalms 119:106**)
