~ **Messianic** ... **Prophecy** ... **Anointed** - I shall sing of your strength and at morning I shall tell of your loving-kindness, you have proved to be a secure height for me and a place of refuge and salvation. (**Psalms 59:16**) [17] - References

Psalms 59:16 But as for me, I shall sing of your strength, and in the morning I shall joyfully tell about your loving-kindness. For you have proved to be a secure height for me and a place to which to flee in the day of my distress.

[17] - References

- As for the Almighty, we **have** not found him out, he is exalted in power, and justice and abundance of righteousness he will not belittle. (**Job 37:23**)
- O be exalted in your **strength**, O Yehowah. We will sing and make melody to your mightiness. (**Psalms 21:13**)
- And he proceeded to save them for the sake of his name, so as to make his mightiness known. (**Psalms 106:8**)
- About the glory of your kingship they will talk, and **about** your mightiness they will speak. (**Psalms 145:11**)
- Yehowah's expressions of **loving-kindness** I will sing **about** even to time indefinite. For generation after generation I shall make your faithfulness known with my mouth. (**Psalms 89:1**)
- About **loving-kindness** and judgment I will sing. To you, O Yehowah, I will make melody. (**Psalms 101:1**)
- In praise of his glorious undeserved kindness which he kindly conferred upon us by means of his loved one. (**Ephesians 1:6**)
- Then David added; Yehowah, who delivered me from the paw of the lion and from the paw of the bear, he it is who will deliver me from the hand of this Philistine. At this Saul said to David; Go, and may Yehowah himself prove to be with you. (**1 Samuel 17:37**)
- For you **have proved** to be a refuge for me, a strong tower in the face of the enemy. (**Psalms 61:3**)

- The name of Yehowah is a strong tower. Into it the righteous runs and is given protection. (**Proverbs 18:10**)
- Consequently Saul sought to pin David to the wall with the spear, but he dodged from before Saul, so that he struck the spear into the wall. And David himself fled that he might escape during that night. (**1 Samuel 19:10**)
- My God is my rock. I shall take refuge in him, my shield and my horn of salvation, my **secure height**, and my **place** for flight, my Savior, from violence you save me. (**2 Samuel 22:3**)
- We will cry out **joyfully** because of your salvation, and in the name of our God we shall lift our banners. May Yehowah fulfill all your requests. (**Psalms 20:5**)
- Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God the God of my salvation, that my tongue may **joyfully tell about** your righteousness. (**Psalms 51:14**)
- In the **morning** cause me to hear your **loving-kindness**, for in you I **have** put my trust. Make known to me the way in which I should walk, for to you I **have** lifted up my soul. (**Psalms 143:8**)
- O Yehowah, undertake to save me, and we shall play my string selections all the **days** of our life at the house of Yehowah. (**Isaiah 38:20**)
- Do not become something terrifying to me. You are my refuge in the **day** of calamity. (**Jeremiah 17:17**)
