- So he disguised his sanity under their eyes and began acting insane in their hand and kept making cross marks on the doors of the gate and let his saliva run down upon his beard. (**1 Samuel 21:13**)
- But about the middle of the night Paul and Silas were praying and praising God with song, yes, the prisoners were hearing them. (**Acts of Apostles 16:25**)
- In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ giving thanks always for all things to our God and Father. (**Ephesians 5:20**)
- In God we will offer praise all day long, and to time indefinite your name we shall laud. (**Psalms 44:8**)
- My mouth is filled with your praise, all day long, with your beauty. (**Psalms 71:8**)
- And too this is what the king said; Blessed be Yehowah the God of Israel, who has today given one to sit upon my throne, with my own eyes seeing it! (**1 Kings 1:48**)
- And say; Naked I came out of my mother's belly, and naked shall I return there. Yehowah himself has given, and Yehowah himself has taken away. Let the name of Yehowah continue to be blessed. (**Job 1:21**)
- O Yehowah, may you open these lips of mine, that my own mouth may tell forth your praise. (**Psalms 51:15**)

- The **praise** of **Yehowah** my **mouth will** speak, and let all flesh **bless** his holy name to time indefinite, even forever. (**Psalms 145:21**)
