Isaiah 45:17· As for Israel, he will certainly be saved in union with Yehowah with a salvation for times indefinite. **YOU** people will not be ashamed, nor will **YOU** be humiliated for the indefinite times of eternity.

- But to the house of Judah I shall show mercy, and I **will** save them by **Yehowah** their God, but I shall not save them by a bow or by a sword or by war, by horses or by horsemen. **(Hosea 1:7)**
- Trust in **Yehowah**, **you** people, for all **times**, for in Yah, **Yehowah** is the Rock of **times indefinite**. **(Isaiah 26:4)**
- Therefore this is what **Yehowah** has said to the house of Jacob, he that redeemed Abraham; Jacob **will** not now be **ashamed**, nor **will** his own face now grow pale. **(Isaiah 29:22)**
- Raise **YOUR** eyes to the heavens themselves, and look at the earth beneath. For the very heavens must be dispersed in fragments just like smoke, and like a garment the earth itself **will** wear out, and its inhabitants themselves **will** die like a mere gnat. But as for my **salvation**, it **will** prove to be even to time **indefinite**, and my own righteousness **will** not be shattered. **(Isaiah 51:6)**
- Do not be afraid, for you **will** not be put to shame, and do not feel **humiliated**, for you **will** not be disappointed. For you **will** forget even the shame of your time of youth, and the reproach of your continuous widowhood you **will** remember no more. **(Isaiah 54:4)**
- Also, none of those hoping in you **will** be **ashamed**. They **will** be **ashamed** who are dealing treacherously without success. **(Psalms 25:3)**
- And **you will certainly** eat, eating and becoming satisfied, and **you will** be bound to praise the name of **Yehowah** **YOUR** God, who has done

with you so wonderfully, and my people will not be ashamed to time indefinite. (Joel 2:26)

- In that day you will not be ashamed because of all your dealings with which you transgressed against me, for then I shall remove from the midst of you your haughtily exultant ones, and you will never again be haughty in my holy mountain. (Zephaniah 3:11)

- The true God is for us a God of saving acts, and to Yehowah the Sovereign Lord belong the ways out from death. (Psalms 68:20)

- In you, O Yehowah, I have taken refuge. O may I never be ashamed. (Psalms 71:1)

- With length of days I shall satisfy him, and I shall cause him to see salvation by me. (Psalms 91:16)

- Support me according to your saying, that I may keep living, and do not put me to shame for my hope. (Psalms 119:116)

- Look! God is my salvation. I shall trust and be in no dread, for Yah, Yehowah is my strength and my might, and he came to be the salvation of me. (Isaiah 12:2)

- In those days Judah will be saved and Jerusalem itself will reside in security. And this is what she will be called, Yehowah Is Our Righteousness. (Jeremiah 33:16)

- For the inhabitress of Maroth has waited for good, but what is bad has come down from Yehowah to the gate of Jerusalem. (Micah 1:12)
