- Hope in Yehowah, be courageous and let your heart be strong. Yes, hope in Yehowah. **(Psalms 27:14)**
- Hope in Yehowah and keep his way, and he will exalt you to take possession of the earth. When the wicked ones are cut off, you will see it. **(Psalms 37:34)**
- Happy is the one who has the God of Jacob for his help, whose hope is in Yehowah his God. **(Psalms 146:5)**
- The mountains themselves proceeded to melt just like wax on account of Yehowah, on account of the Lord of the whole earth. **(Psalms 97:5)**
- We will cry out joyfully because of your salvation, and in the name of our God we shall lift our banners. May Yehowah fulfill all your requests. **(Psalms 20:5)**
- O Yehowah, in your strength the king rejoices, and in your salvation how very joyful he wants to be! **(Psalms 21:1)**
- Indeed toward God is my soul waiting in silence. From him my salvation is. **(Psalms 62:1)**
- O come let us cry out joyfully to Yehowah! Let us shout in triumph to our Rock of salvation. **(Psalms 95:1)**

- For I shall declare the name of **Yehowah**. Do **you** attribute greatness to our **God**! (**Deuteronomy 32:3**)
- O **Yehowah**, you are my **God**. I exalt you, I laud your name, for you **have** done wonderful things, counsels from early times, in faithfulness, in trustworthiness. (**Isaiah 25:1**)
- After these things I heard what was as a loud voice of a great crowd in heaven. They said; Praise Yah, **you** people! The **salvation** and the glory and the power belong to our **God**. (**Revelation 19:1**)
- I shall indeed wait for **salvation** from you, O **Yehowah**. (**Genesis 49:18**)
- Do not **say**; I **will** pay back evil! Hope in **Yehowah**, and he **will save** you. (**Proverbs 20:22**)
- Because my eyes **have** seen your means of saving. (**Luke 2:30**)
- And **God** went on to speak to Moses and to **say** to him; I am **Yehowah**. (**Exodus 6:2**)
- And I shall **certainly** let remain in the midst of you a people humble and lowly, and they **will** actually take refuge in the name of **Yehowah**. (**Zephaniah 3:12**)
- But as for me, it is for **Yehowah** that I shall keep on the lookout. I **will** show a waiting attitude for the **God** of my **salvation**. My **God will** hear me. (**Micah 7:7**)
- Joyfully cry out, O daughter of Zion! Break out in cheers, O Israel! Rejoice and exult with all the heart, O daughter of Jerusalem! (**Zephaniah 3:14**)
- **Yehowah** has removed the judgments upon you. He has turned away your enemy. The king of Israel, **Yehowah**, is in the midst of you. You **will** fear calamity no more. (**Zephaniah 3:15**)
- In that day it **will** be said to Jerusalem; Do not be afraid, O Zion. May your hands not drop down. (**Zephaniah 3:16**)
- **Yehowah** your **God** is in the midst of you. As a mighty One, he **will save**. He **will** exult over you with rejoicing. He **will** become silent in his love. He **will** be **joyful** over you with happy cries. (**Zephaniah 3:17**)
- Before Ephraim and Benjamin and Manasseh do rouse up your mightiness, and do come to our **salvation**. (**Psalms 80:2**)

- O **Yehowah**, show us favor. In you we **have hoped**. Become our arm every morning, yes, our **salvation** in the time of distress. (**Isaiah 33:2**)
- Say to those who are anxious at heart; Be strong. Do not be afraid. Look! **YOUR** own **God will** come with vengeance itself, **God** even with a repayment. He himself **will** come and **save you** people. (**Isaiah 35:4**)
- And kings must become caretakers for you, and their princesses nursing women for you. With faces to the earth they **will** bow down to you, and the dust of your feet they **will** lick up, and you **will have** to know that I am **Yehowah**, of whom those hoping in me **will** not be ashamed. (**Isaiah 49:23**)
- Without fail I shall exult in **Yehowah**. My soul **will** be **joyful** in my **God**. For he has clothed me with the garments of **salvation**, with the sleeveless coat of righteousness he has enwrapped me, like the bridegroom who, in a priestly way, puts on a headdress, and like the bride who decks herself with her ornamental things. (**Isaiah 61:10**)
- Who is this one coming from Edom, the one with garments of glowing colors from Bozrah, this one who is honorable in his clothing, marching in the abundance of his power? I, the One speaking in righteousness, the One abounding in power to save. (**Isaiah 63:1**)
- And from time long ago none **have** heard, nor **have** any given ear, nor has an eye itself seen a **God**, except you, that acts for the one that keeps in expectation of him. (**Isaiah 64:4**)
- Good is **Yehowah** to the one hoping in him, to the soul that keeps seeking for him. (**Lamentations 3:25**)
