- And you must love **Yehowah** your God with your whole heart and with your whole soul and with your whole mind and with your whole strength. (**Mark 12:30**)
- But if anyone loves God, this one is known by him. (**1 Corinthians 8:3**)
- Turn away from **what is bad**, and do **what** is good, seek to find peace, and pursue it. (**Psalms 34:14**)
- Turn away from **what is bad** and do **what** is good, and so reside to time indefinite. (**Psalms 37:27**)
- I shall not set in front of my eyes any good-for-nothing thing. The doing of those who fall away I have hated, it does not cling to me. (**Psalms 101:3**)
- Owing to your orders I behave with understanding. That is why I have hated every false path. (**Psalms 119:104**)
- Hate **what** is **bad**, and love **what** is good, and give justice a place in the gate. It may be that **Yehowah** the God of armies will show favor to the remaining **ones** of Joseph. (**Amos 5:15**)
- For **what** I am working **out** I do not know. For **what** I wish, this I do not practice, but **what** I hate is **what** I do. (**Romans 7:15**)
- Let **YOUR** love be without hypocrisy. Abhor **what** is **wicked**, cling to **what** is good. (**Romans 12:9**)

- You loved righteousness, and you hated Lawlessness. That is why God, your God, anointed you with the oil of exultation more than your partners. (**Hebrews 1:9**)
- Save them by snatching them **out** of the fire. But continue showing mercy to others, doing so with fear, while **you hate** even the inner garment that has been stained by the flesh. (**Jude 1:23**)
- O love **Yehowah**, all **you loyal ones** of his. The faithful **ones Yehowah** is safeguarding, but he is rewarding exceedingly anyone showing haughtiness. (**Psalms 31:23**)
- For **Yehowah** is a lover of justice, and he will not leave his **loyal ones**. To time indefinite they will certainly be guarded, but as for the offspring of the **wicked ones**, they will indeed be cut off. (**Psalms 37:28**)
- **Yehowah** is **guarding** all those loving him, but all the **wicked ones** he will annihilate. (**Psalms 145:20**)
- By observing the paths of judgment, and he will guard the very way of his **loyal ones**. (**Proverbs 2:8**)
- And the salvation of the righteous **ones** is from **Yehowah**, he is their fortress in the time of distress. (**Psalms 37:39**)
- For the scepter of wickedness will not keep resting upon the lot of the righteous **ones**, in order, that the righteous **ones** may not thrust **out** their **hand** upon any wrongdoing. (**Psalms 125:3**)
- And I will deliver you **out** of the **hand** of the **bad ones**, and I will redeem you **out** of the palm of the tyrannical **ones**. (**Jeremiah 15:21**)
- Nebuchadnezzar was answering and saying; Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, who sent his angel and rescued his servants that trusted in him and that changed the very word of the king and gave over their bodies, because they would not serve and would not worship any god at all except their own God. (**Daniel 3:28**)
- And do not bring us into temptation, but deliver us from the **wicked one**. (**Matthew 6:13**)
- When Reuben heard this he tried to deliver him **out** of their **hand**. So he said; Let us not strike his soul fatally. (**Genesis 37:21**)
- Thus let all your enemies perish, O **Yehowah**, and let your **lovers** be as when the sun goes forth in its mightiness. And the land had no further disturbance for forty years. (**Judges 5:31**)

- The feet of his **loyal ones** he guards. As for the **wicked ones**, they are silenced in darkness, for not by power does a man prove superior. **(1 Samuel 2:9)**
- Then David added; Yehowah, who delivered me from the paw of the lion and from the paw of the bear, he it is who will deliver me from the **hand** of this Philistine. At this Saul said to David; Go, and may **Yehowah** himself prove to be with you. **(1 Samuel 17:37)**
- With someone **loyal** you will act in loyalty, with the faultless, mighty one you will deal faultlessly. **(2 Samuel 22:26)**
- But Naboth said to Ahab; It is unthinkable on my part, from Yehowah's standpoint, for me to give the hereditary possession of my forefathers to you. **(1 Kings 21:3)**
- With someone **loyal** you will act in loyalty, with the faultless, able-bodied man you will deal faultlessly. **(Psalms 18:25)**
- For he has acted too smoothly to himself in his own eyes to find **out** his error so as to **hate** it. **(Psalms 36:2)**
- **Yehowah** himself will guard you against all calamity. He will guard your soul. **(Psalms 121:7)**
- The fear of **Yehowah** means the hating of **bad**. Self-exaltation and pride and the **bad** way and the perverse mouth I have hated. **(Proverbs 8:13)**
