- How lovely your grand tabernacle is, O **Yehowah** of armies! (**Psalms 84:1**)
- For a day in your courtyards is better than a thousand elsewhere. I **have** chosen to stand at the threshold in the **house** of my God rather than to move around in the tents of wickedness. (**Psalms 84:10**)

- Two things I **have asked** of you. Do not withhold them from me before I die. (**Proverbs 30:7**)
