

ANOINTED - MY SIN I CONFESSED TO YOU, I SHOWED MY ERROR

Psalms 32:5· My sin I finally confessed to you, and my error I did not cover. I said; I shall make confession over my transgressions to Yehowah. And you yourself pardoned the error of my sins.

- For I proceeded to tell about my own **error**, I began to be anxious over my sin. (**Psalms 38:18**)
- Against you, you alone, I have sinned, and what is bad in your eyes I have done, in order, that you may prove to be righteous when you speak, that you may be in the clear when you judge. (**Psalms 51:4**)
- If we confess our **sins**, he is faithful and righteous so as to forgive us our **sins** and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness. (**1 John 1:9**)
- And it must occur that in case he becomes guilty as respects one of these things, then he must confess in what way he has sinned. (**Leviticus 5:5**)
- David now **said** to Nathan; **I** have sinned against **Yehowah**. At this Nathan **said** to David; Yehowah, in turn, does let your sin pass by. You will not die. (**2 Samuel 12:13**)
- Moreover, Hezekiah spoke to the heart of all the Levites who were acting with fine discretion toward Yehowah. And they proceeded to eat the appointed feast for seven days, sacrificing communion sacrifices and making **confession** to Yehowah the God of their forefathers. (**2 Chronicles 30:22**)
- For I proceeded to tell about my own **error**, I began to be anxious over my sin. (**Psalms 38:18**)
- As for me, **I said**; O Yehowah, show me favor. Do heal my soul, for I have sinned against you. (**Psalms 41:4**)

- And people were baptized by him in the Jordan River, openly confessing their **sins**. (**Matthew 3:6**)
- For you, O Yehowah, are good and ready to forgive, and the loving-kindness to all those calling upon you is abundant. (**Psalms 86:5**)
- Him who is forgiving all your **error**, who is healing all your maladies. (**Psalms 103:3**)
- I will wipe out your **transgressions** just as with a cloud, and your **sins** just as with a cloud mass. Do return to me, for I will repurchase you. (**Isaiah 44:22**)
- Take with yourselves words and come back to Yehowah. Say to him, all **you** people, May you pardon **error**, and accept what is good, and we will offer in return the young bulls of our lips. (**Hosea 14:2**)
- By virtue of this, I tell you, her **sins**, many though they are, are forgiven, because she loved much, but he who is forgiven little, loves little. (**Luke 7:47**)
- And they must confess their sin that they have done, and he must return the amount of his guilt in its principal, also adding a fifth of it to it, and he must give it to the one against whom he did wrong. (**Numbers 5:7**)
- Then Joshua **said** to Achan; My son, render, please, glory to Yehowah the God of Israel and **make confession** to him, and tell me, please, What have you done? Do not hide it from me. (**Joshua 7:19**)
- Now as soon as Ezra had prayed and he had made **confession** while weeping and lying prostrate before the house of the true God, those of Israel collected themselves together to him, a very large congregation, men and women and children, for the people had wept profusely. (**Ezra 10:1**)
- And now **make confession** to Yehowah the God of **YOUR** forefathers and do his pleasure and separate yourselves from the peoples of the land and from the foreign wives. (**Ezra 10:11**)
- Please, let your ear become attentive and your eyes opened, to listen to the prayer of your servant, which I am praying before you today, day and night, concerning the sons of Israel your servants, all the while making **confession** concerning the **sins** of the sons of Israel with which we have sinned against you. We have sinned, both I and the house of my father. (**Nehemiah 1:6**)

- He will sing to men and say, I have sinned, and what is upright I have perverted, and it certainly was not the proper thing for me. (**Job 33:27**)
- See my affliction and my trouble, and pardon all my **sins**. (**Psalms 25:18**)
- For my **transgressions** I myself know, and my sin is in front of me constantly. (**Psalms 51:3**)
- He that is covering over his **transgressions** will not succeed, but he that is confessing and leaving them will be shown mercy. (**Proverbs 28:13**)
- While I was yet speaking and praying and confessing my sin and the sin of my people Israel and letting my request for favor fall before Yehowah my God concerning the holy mountain of my God. (**Daniel 9:20**)
- Thereupon the scribes and the Pharisees started to reason, saying; Who is this that is speaking blasphemies? Who can forgive **sins** except God alone? (**Luke 5:21**)
- I will rise and journey to my father and say to him; Father, I have sinned against heaven and against you. (**Luke 15:18**)
- For sadness in a godly way **makes** for repentance to salvation that is not to be regretted, but the sadness of the world produces death. (**2 Corinthians 7:10**)
- Therefore openly confess **YOUR sins** to one another and pray for one another, that **YOU** may get healed. A righteous man's supplication, when it is at work, has much force. (**James 5:16**)
