**Psalms 91:8**· Only with your eyes will you look on and see the retribution itself of the wicked ones.

[13] - References

- Hope in Yehowah and keep his way, and he **will** exalt you to take possession of the earth. When the **wicked ones** are cut off, you **will see** it. (Psalms 37:34)
- And **YOUR** own **eyes will see** it, and **YOU** yourselves **will say**; May Yehowah be magnified over the territory of Israel. (Malachi 1:5)
- Woe to the **wicked** one! Calamity, for the treatment rendered by his own hands **will** be rendered to him! (Isaiah 3:11)
- And **YOU** people **will** again certainly **see** the distinction between a righteous one and a **wicked** one, between one serving God and one who has not served him. (Malachi 3:18)
- Thus on that day Yehowah saved Israel from the hand of the Egyptians, and Israel got to **see** the Egyptians dead on the seashore. (Exodus 14:30)
- For out of every distress he delivered me, and upon my enemies my eye has looked. (Psalms 54:7)
- And my eye **will look** on my foes, my ears **will** hear about the very **ones** who rise up against me, the evildoers. (Psalms 92:11)
- His heart is unshakable, he **will** not be afraid, until he **looks** on his adversaries. (Psalms 112:8)
- The Righteous One is giving consideration to the house of the **wicked** one, subverting the **wicked ones** to their calamity. (Proverbs 21:12)

- When the **wicked** become many, transgression abounds, but those who are righteous **will look** on their very downfall. (**Proverbs 29:16**)
- Go, and you must say to Ebed-melech the Ethiopian; This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Here I am bringing true my words upon this city for calamity and not for good, and they **will** certainly happen before you in that day. (**Jeremiah 39:16**)
- When he **sees** and he turns back from all his transgressions that he has done, he **will** positively keep living. He **will** not die. (**Ezekiel 18:28**)
- So right away I said to him; My lord, you are the one that knows. And he said to me; These are the **ones** that come out of the great tribulation, and they have washed their robes and made them white in the blood of the Lamb. (**Revelation 7:14**)
