- Sing to **Yehowah** a **new song**. Sing to **Yehowah**, all **YOU** people of the earth. (**Psalms 96:1**)
- Praise Yah, **YOU** people! Sing to **Yehowah** a **new song**, this praise in the congregation of loyal ones. (**Psalms 149:1**)
- Sing to **Yehowah** a **new song**, his praise from the extremity of the earth, **YOU** men that are going down to the sea and to that which fills it, **YOU** islands and **YOU** inhabiting them. (**Isaiah 42:10**)
- Who among the gods is like you, O **Yehowah** Who is like you, proving yourself mighty in holiness. The One to be feared with **songs** of praise, the One doing marvels. (**Exodus 15:11**)
- You are the true God, doing marvelously. Among the peoples you have made your strength known. (**Psalms 77:14**)

- To the Doer of **wonderful**, great **things** by himself; for his loving-kindness is to time indefinite. (**Psalms 136:4**)

- Which we do not hide from their sons, relating them **even** to the generation to come, the praises of **Yehowah** and his strength and his **wonderful things** that he **has** done. (**Psalms 78:4**)
- To make known to the sons of men his mighty acts and the glory of the splendor of his kingship. (**Psalms 145:12**)
- Make melody to **Yehowah**, for he **has** done surpassingly. This is made known in all the earth. (**Isaiah 12:5**)
- O **Yehowah**, you are my God. I exalt you, I laud your name, for you have done **wonderful things**, counsels from early times, in faithfulness, in trustworthiness. (**Isaiah 25:1**)
- And **Yehowah** will certainly make the dignity of his voice to be heard and will make the descending of his **arm** to be seen, in the raging of anger and the flame of a devouring fire and cloudburst and rainstorm and hailstones. (**Isaiah 30:30**)
