

ANOINTED - THE HEAVENS ARE MY THRONE AND THE EARTH MY

~ **Messianic ... Prophecy ... Anointed** - The heavens are my throne and the earth my footstool, Where then is the house you can build for me as my resting place' (Isaiah 66:1) [\[22\] - References](#)

Isaiah 66:1· This is what Yehowah has said; The heavens are my throne, and the earth is my footstool. Where, then, is the house that **YOU** people can build for me, and where, then, is the place as a resting-place for me?

- But will God truly dwell with mankind upon the **earth**? Look! Heaven, yes, the heaven of the **heavens** themselves, cannot contain you, how much less, then, this **house** that I have built? (2 Chronicles 6:18)
- Coming to him as to a living stone, rejected, it is true, by men, but chosen, precious, with God. (1 Peter 2:4)
- **You** yourselves also as living stones are being built up a spiritual **house** for the purpose of a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Jesus Christ. (1 Peter 2:5)
- For it is contained in Scripture: Look! I am laying in Zion a stone, chosen, a foundation cornerstone, precious, and no one exercising faith in it will by any means come to disappointment. (1 Peter 2:6)
- It is to **you**, therefore, that he is precious, because **you** are believers, but to those not believing, the identical stone that the builders rejected **has** become the head of the corner. (1 Peter 2:7)
- And a stone of stumbling and a rock-mass of offense. These are stumbling because they are disobedient to the word. To this very end they were also appointed. (1 Peter 2:8)
- But **you** are a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a **people** for special possession, that **you** should declare abroad the excellencies of the one that called **you** out of darkness into his wonderful light. (1 Peter 2:9)

- **Yehowah** is in his holy temple. **Yehowah**, in the **heavens** is his **throne**. His own eyes behold, his own beaming eyes examine the sons of men. (**Psalms 11:4**)
- He is condescending to look on heaven and **earth**. (**Psalms 113:6**)
- Let them praise the name of **Yehowah**, for his name alone is unreachably high. His dignity is above **earth** and heaven. (**Psalms 148:13**)
- Nor by **earth**, because it is the **footstool** of his feet, nor by Jerusalem, because it is the city of the great King. (**Matthew 5:35**)
- Nevertheless, the Most High does not dwell in **houses** made with hands, just as the prophet says. (**Acts of Apostles 7:48**)
- The heaven is my **throne**, and the **earth** is my **footstool**. What sort of **house** will **you** **build** for me? **Yehowah** says. Or what is the **place** for my resting? (**Acts of Apostles 7:49**)
- Saying; Because a hand is against the **throne** of Yah, **Yehowah** will have war with Amalek from generation to generation. (**Exodus 17:16**)
- Behold, to **Yehowah** your God belong the **heavens**, even the **heavens** of the **heavens**, the **earth** and all that is in it. (**Deuteronomy 10:14**)
- But will God truly dwell upon the **earth**? Look! The **heavens**, yes, the heaven of the **heavens**, themselves cannot contain you, how much less, then, this **house** that I have built! (**1 Kings 8:27**)
- And who could retain power to **build** him a **house**? For the **heavens** and the heaven of the **heavens** cannot contain him, and who am I that I should **build** him a **house** except for making sacrificial smoke before him? (**2 Chronicles 2:6**)
- Exalt **Yehowah** our God and bow down yourselves at his **footstool**, he is holy. (**Psalms 99:5**)
- **Yehowah** himself **has** firmly established his **throne** in the very **heavens**, and over everything his own kingship **has** held domination. (**Psalms 103:19**)
- As regards the **heavens**, to **Yehowah** the **heavens** belong, but the **earth** he **has** given to the sons of men. (**Psalms 115:16**)
- **Yehowah** will certainly be put on high, for he is residing in the height. He must fill Zion with justice and righteousness. (**Isaiah 33:5**)

- To you the very glory of Lebanon will come, the juniper tree, the ash tree and the cypress at the same time, in order to beautify the **place** of my sanctuary, and I shall glorify the very **place** of my feet. **(Isaiah 60:13)**
- Or can any man be concealed in **places** of concealment and I myself not see him? is the utterance of **Yehowah**. Is it not the **heavens** and the **earth** that I myself actually fill, is the utterance of **Yehowah**? **(Jeremiah 23:24)**
- And because they **said** to leave the rootstock of the tree, your kingdom will be sure to you after you know that the **heavens** are ruling. **(Daniel 4:26)**
- Nevertheless, the Most High does not dwell in **houses** made with hands, just as the prophet says. **(Acts of Apostles 7:48)**
