- And the righteous ones **will** see it and **will** be afraid, and over him they **will** laugh. (**Psalms 52:6**)
- And the righteous one **will rejoice** in Yehowah and **will** indeed take refuge in him, and all the upright in heart **will** boast. (**Psalms 64:10**)
- The upright ones see and **rejoice**, but as for all unrighteousness, it **has** to shut its mouth. (**Psalms 107:42**)
- And I **will** execute in them great acts of **vengeance**, with raging reproofs, and they **will** have to know that I am Yehowah when I bring my **vengeance** on them. (**Ezekiel 25:17**)
- Be glad over her, O heaven, also **you** holy ones and **you** apostles and **you** prophets, because God **has** judicially exacted punishment for **you** from her! (**Revelation 18:20**)
- In order, that you may wash your foot in **blood**, that the tongue of your dogs may have its portion from the enemies. (**Psalms 68:23**)
- The **wicked** is a ransom for the righteous one, and the one dealing treacherously takes the place of the upright ones. (**Proverbs 21:18**)
- And the winepress was trodden outside the city, and **blood** came out of the winepress as high up as the bridles of the horses, for a distance of a thousand six hundred furlongs. (**Revelation 14:20**)
- Thus on that day Yehowah saved Israel from the hand of the Egyptians, and Israel got to see the Egyptians dead on the seashore. (**Exodus 14:30**)

- Thus God made the evil of Abimelech that he had done to his father by killing his seventy brothers come back. (**Judges 9:56**)
- Samson now called to Yehowah and said; Sovereign Lord Yehowah, remember me, please, and strengthen me, please, just this once, O you the true God, and let me avenge myself upon the Philistines with **vengeance** for one of my two eyes. (**Judges 16:28**)
- Then the man of the true God approached and said to the king of Israel, yes, he went on to say; This is what Yehowah **has** said; For the reason that the Syrians have said; Yehowah is a God of mountains, and he is not a God of low plains, I shall have to give all this great crowd into your hand, and **you** men **will** certainly know that I am Yehowah. (**1 Kings 20:28**)
- Finally he came to Samaria. Now he went striking down all who were left over of Ahab's in Samaria, until he had annihilated them, according to Yehowah's word that he had spoken to Elijah. (**2 Kings 10:17**)

- Like the heat in a waterless country, the noise of strangers you subdue, the heat with the shadow of a cloud. The melody itself of the tyrannical ones becomes suppressed. (**Isaiah 25:5**)
- And they **will** actually go forth and look upon the carcasses of the men that were transgressing against me, for the very worms upon them **will** not die and their fire itself **will** not be extinguished, and they must become something repulsive to all flesh. (**Isaiah 66:24**)
- And I **will** bring my **vengeance** on Edom by the hand of my people Israel, and they must do in Edom according to my anger and according to my rage, and they **will** have to know what my **vengeance** is, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 25:14**)
- And my enemy **will** see, and shame **will** cover her, who was saying to me; Where is he, Yehowah your God? My own eyes **will** look upon her. Now she **will** become a place of trampling, like the mire of streets. (**Micah 7:10**)
