

ANOINTED - THE VERY ONES REDEEMED BY YEHOWAH RETURN TO ZION

Isaiah 35:10 And the very ones redeemed by Yehowah will return and certainly come to Zion with a joyful cry, and rejoicing to time indefinite will be upon their head. To exultation and rejoicing they will attain, and grief and sighing must flee away.

- With that I heard a loud voice from the throne say; Look! The tent of God is with mankind, and he **will** reside with them, and they **will** be his peoples. And God himself **will** be with them. (**Revelation 21:3**)
- And he **will** wipe out every tear from their eyes, and death **will** be no more, neither **will** mourning nor outcry nor pain be anymore. The former things have passed away. (**Revelation 21:4**)
- If your dispersed people should be at the end of the heavens, from there **Yehowah** your God **will** collect you and from there he **will** take you. (**Deuteronomy 30:4**)
- Then the **redeemed** ones of **Yehowah** themselves **will return** and **must come** to **Zion** with a **joyful** outcry, and **rejoicing** to time **indefinite will** be upon their **head**. To **exultation** and **rejoicing** they **will attain**. Grief and **sighing will certainly flee away**. (**Isaiah 51:11**)
- Just as the Son of man came, not to be ministered to, but to minister and to give his soul a ransom in exchange for many. (**Matthew 20:28**)
- Who gave himself a corresponding ransom for all, this is what is to be witnessed to at its own particular times. (**1 Timothy 2:6**)
- And they **will certainly come** and **cry** out joyfully on the height of **Zion** and become radiant over the goodness of **Yehowah**, over the grain and over the new wine and over the oil and over the young ones of the flock and the cattle. And their soul **will** simply become like a well-

watered garden, and no more **will** they languish again. (**Jeremiah 31:12**)

- The sound of **exultation** and the sound of **rejoicing**, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those saying; **LAUD Yehowah** of armies, for **Yehowah** is good, for to time **indefinite** is his loving-kindness! They **will** be bringing a thanksgiving offering into the house of **Yehowah**, for I shall bring back the captives of the land just as at the start, **Yehowah** has said. (**Jeremiah 33:11**)

- When the very people in **Zion will** dwell in Jerusalem, you **will** by no means weep. He **will** without fail show you favor at the sound of your outcry, as soon as he hears it he **will** actually answer you. (**Isaiah 30:19**)

- And I **will** be **joyful** in Jerusalem and exult in my people, and no more **will** there be heard in her the sound of weeping or the sound of a plaintive cry. (**Isaiah 65:19**)

- It was then that Solomon proceeded to congregate the older men of Israel and all the **heads** of the tribes, the chieftains of the paternal houses of the sons of Israel, to Jerusalem, to bring the ark of the covenant of **Yehowah** up from the City of David, that is to say, **Zion**. (**2 Chronicles 5:2**)

- And many of the priests and the Levites and the **heads** of the paternal houses, the old men that had seen the former house, were weeping with a loud voice at the laying of the foundation of this house before their eyes, while many others were raising the voice in shouting for joy. (**Ezra 3:12**)

- Let the reclaimed ones of **Yehowah** say so, whom he has reclaimed from the hand of the adversary. (**Psalms 107:2**)

- For there those holding us captive asked us for the words of a song, and those mocking us, for **rejoicing**; **SING** for us one of the songs of Zion. (**Psalms 137:3**)

- There is a hard vision that has been told to me; The treacherous dealer is dealing treacherously, and the despoiler is despoiling. Go up, O Elam! Lay siege, O Media! All **sighing** due to her I have caused to cease. (**Isaiah 21:2**)

- He **will** actually swallow up death forever, and the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah will certainly** wipe the tears from all faces. And the reproach of his people he **will** take **away** from all the earth, for **Yehowah** himself has spoken it. (**Isaiah 25:8**)

- Instead of your proving to be one left entirely and hated, with nobody passing through, I **will** even set you as a thing of pride to time **indefinite**, an **exultation** for generation after generation. (**Isaiah 60:15**)
- No more **will** your sun set, nor **will** your moon go on the wane, for **Yehowah** himself **will** become for you an indefinitely lasting light, and the days of your mourning **will** have **come** to completion. (**Isaiah 60:20**)
- Instead of **YOUR** shame there **will** be a double portion, and instead of humiliation they **will** cry out joyfully over their share. Therefore in their land they **will** take possession of even a double portion. Rejoicing to time **indefinite** is what **will come** to be theirs. (**Isaiah 61:7**)
- And I myself shall collect together the remnant of my sheep out of all the lands to which I had dispersed them, and I **will** bring them back to their pasture ground, and they **will certainly** be fruitful and become many. (**Jeremiah 23:3**)
- And from them there **will certainly** go forth thanksgiving, and the sound of those who are laughing. And I **will** multiply them, and they **will** not become few, and I **will** make them heavy in number, and they **will** not become insignificant. (**Jeremiah 30:19**)
- To **Zion** they **will** keep asking the way, with their faces in that direction, saying; Come and let us join ourselves to **Yehowah** in an indefinitely lasting covenant that **will** not be forgotten. (**Jeremiah 50:5**)
- Cry out loudly and rejoice, O daughter of **Zion**, for here I am coming, and I **will** reside in the midst of you, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. (**Zechariah 2:10**)
- For there **will** be the seed of peace, the vine itself **will** give its fruitage, and the earth itself **will** give its yield, and the heavens themselves **will** give their dew, and I shall **certainly** cause the remaining ones of this people to inherit all these things. (**Zechariah 8:12**)
- This is what **Yehowah** of armies has said; The fast of the fourth month, and the fast of the fifth month, and the fast of the seventh month, and the fast of the tenth month **will** become for the house of Judah an **exultation** and a **rejoicing** and good festal seasons. So love truth and peace. (**Zechariah 8:19**)
- Christ by purchase released us from the curse of the Law by becoming a curse instead of us, because it is written: Accursed is every man hanged upon a stake. (**Galatians 3:13**)

- Be obedient to those who are taking the lead among **YOU** and be submissive, for they are keeping watch over **YOUR** souls as those who **will** render an account, that they may do this with joy and not with **sighing**, for this would be damaging to **YOU**. (**Hebrews 13:17**)
