

ANOINTED - THEN THE REDEEMED ONES OF YEHOWAH WILL RETURN

~ **Messianic ... Prophecy ... Anointed** - Then the redeemed ones of Yehowah will return to Zion with joyful outcry and rejoicing to time indefinite, to exaltation and rejoicing they will attain, grief and sighing will flee away from them' (**Isaiah 51:11**) ^{[12] - References}

Isaiah 51:11· Then the redeemed ones of Yehowah themselves will return and must come to Zion with a joyful outcry, and rejoicing to time indefinite will be upon their head. To exultation and rejoicing they will attain. Grief and sighing will certainly flee away.

[12] - References

- He **will** actually swallow up death forever, and the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah will certainly** wipe the tears from all faces. And the reproach of his people he **will take away** from all the earth, for **Yehowah** himself has spoken it. (**Isaiah 25:8**)
- And the very **ones** redeemed by **Yehowah will return** and **certainly come** to **Zion** with a **joyful** cry, and **rejoicing** to time **indefinite** will be upon their **head**. To **exultation** and **rejoicing** they **will attain**, and grief and **sighing must flee away**. (**Isaiah 35:10**)
- Instead of **YOUR** shame there **will** be a double portion, and instead of humiliation they **will** cry out joyfully over their share. Therefore in their land they **will** take possession of even a double portion. Rejoicing to time **indefinite** is what **will come** to be theirs. (**Isaiah 61:7**)
- But exult, **YOU** people, and be **joyful** forever in what I am creating. For here I am creating Jerusalem a cause for joyfulness and her people a cause for **exultation**. (**Isaiah 65:18**)
- And I **will** be **joyful** in Jerusalem and exult in my people, and no more **will** there be heard in her the sound of weeping or the sound of a plaintive cry. (**Isaiah 65:19**)
- For **Yehowah will** actually redeem Jacob and reclaim him out of the hand of the one stronger than he is. (**Jeremiah 31:11**)
- And I **must** bring them back from the land of Egypt, and from Assyria I shall collect them together, and to the land of Gilead and

Lebanon I shall bring them, and no room **will** be found for them. (Zechariah 10:10)

- And he **will** send forth his angels with a great trumpet sound, and they **will** gather his chosen **ones** together from the four winds, from one extremity of the heavens to their other extremity. (Matthew 24:31)

- For the name of **Yehowah** to be declared in **Zion** and his praise in Jerusalem. (Psalms 102:21)

- But exult, **you** people, and be **joyful** forever in what I am creating. For here I am creating Jerusalem a cause for joyfulness and her people a cause for **exultation**. (Isaiah 65:18)

- And from them there **will certainly** go forth thanksgiving, and the sound of those who are laughing. And I **will** multiply them, and they **will** not become few, and I **will** make them heavy in number, and they **will** not become insignificant. (Jeremiah 30:19)

- And they **will certainly come** and cry out joyfully on the height of **Zion** and become radiant over the goodness of **Yehowah**, over the grain and over the new wine and over the oil and over the young **ones** of the flock and the cattle. And their soul **will** simply become like a well-watered garden, and no more **will** they languish again. (Jeremiah 31:12)

- I **will** whistle for them and collect them together, for I shall **certainly** redeem them, and they **must** become many, just like those who have become many. (Zechariah 10:8)
