- Old man, young man and virgin and little child and women **you** should kill off, to a ruination. But to any man upon whom there is the mark do not go near, and from my sanctuary **you** should start. So they started with the old men that were before the house. (**Ezekiel 9:6**)

- And, look! The man clothed with the linen, at whose hips there was the inkhorn, was bringing back word, saying; I have done just as you have commanded me. (**Ezekiel 9:11**)
- For it is the appointed time for the judgment to start with the house of God. Now if it starts first with us, **what** will the end be of those who are not obedient to the Good News of God? (**1 Peter 4:17**)
- Do not be misled! God is not one to be mocked. For whatever a man is sowing, this he will also reap. (**Galatians 6:7**)
- Render to her even as she herself rendered, and do to her twice as much, yes, twice the number of the things she did, in the cup in which she put a mixture put twice as much of the mixture for her. (**Revelation 18:6**)
- To the extent that she glorified herself and lived in shameless luxury, to that extent give her torment and mourning. For in her heart

she keeps saying; I sit a queen, and I am no widow, and I shall never see mourning. (**Revelation 18:7**)

- That is why in one day her plagues will come, death and mourning and famine, and she will be completely burned with fire, because **Yehowah** God, who judged her, is strong. (**Revelation 18:8**)

- Be glad over her, O heaven, also **you** holy ones and **you** apostles and **you** prophets, because God has judicially exacted punishment for **you** from her! (**Revelation 18:20**)

- Yes, in her was found the blood of prophets and of holy ones and of all those who have been slaughtered on the earth. (**Revelation 18:24**)

- And no light of a lamp will ever shine in you again, and no voice of a bridegroom and of a bride will ever be heard in you again, because your traveling merchants were the top-ranking men of the earth, for by your spiritistic practice all the nations were misled. (**Revelation 18:23**)

- After these things I heard **what** was as a loud voice of a great crowd in heaven. They said; Praise Yah, **you** people! The salvation and the glory and the power belong to our God. (**Revelation 19:1**)

- Because his judgments are true and righteous. For he has executed judgment upon the great harlot who corrupted the earth with her fornication, and he has avenged the blood of his slaves at her hand. (**Revelation 19:2**)

- And right away for the second time they said; Praise Yah, **you** people! And the smoke from her goes on ascending forever and ever. (**Revelation 19:3**)

- Look! I am sending my messenger, and he must clear up a way before me. And suddenly there will come to His **temple** the true Lord, whom **you** people are seeking, and the messenger of the covenant in whom **you** are delighting. Look! He will certainly come, **Yehowah** of armies has said. (**Malachi 3:1**)

- But who will be putting up with the day of his coming, and who will be the one standing when he appears? For he will be like the fire of a refiner and like the lye of laundrymen. (**Malachi 3:2**)

- Vengeance is mine, and retribution. At the appointed time their foot will move unsteadily, for the day of their disaster is near, and the events in readiness for them do make haste. (**Deuteronomy 32:35**)
- In accordance with the dealings he will reward correspondingly, rage to his adversaries, due treatment to his **enemies**. To the islands he will recompense due treatment. (**Isaiah 59:18**)
- If I do indeed sharpen my glittering sword, and my hand takes hold on judgment, I will pay back vengeance to my adversaries and render retribution to those who intensely hate me. (**Deuteronomy 32:41**)
- To proclaim the year of goodwill on the part of **Yehowah** and the day of vengeance on the part of our God, to comfort all the mourning ones. (**Isaiah 61:2**)
- Neither will my eye feel sorry nor shall I feel compassion. According to your ways shall I do the bringing upon you yourself, and your own detestable things will come to be right in the midst of you, and **you** people will have to know that I am **Yehowah** doing the smiting. (**Ezekiel 7:9**)
