- By the rivers of Babylon, there we sat down. We also wept when we remembered Zion. (**Psalms 137:1**)
- With weeping they **will** come, and with their entreaties for favor I shall bring them. I shall make them walk to torrent valleys of water, in a right way in which they **will** not be caused to stumble. For I have become to Israel a Father, and as for Ephraim, he is my firstborn. (**Jeremiah 31:9**)
- Happy are those who mourn, since they **will** be comforted. (**Matthew 5:4**)
- Most truly I say to **YOU**, **YOU will** weep and wail, but the world **will** rejoice, **YOU will** be grieved, but **YOUR** grief **will** be turned into joy. (**John 16:20**)
- Go back, and you must say to Hezekiah the leader of my people, This is what Yehowah the God of David your forefather has said; I have heard your prayer. I have seen your **tears**. Here I am healing you. On the third day you **will** go up to the house of Yehowah. (**2 Kings 20:5**)
