- With that I heard a loud voice from the throne say; Look! The **tent** of God is with mankind, and he **will reside** with them, and they **will** be his peoples. And God himself **will** be with them. (**Revelation 21:3**)
- Saying; I, even I, have installed my king upon Zion, my **holy** mountain. (**Psalms 2:6**)
- With my voice I shall call to Yehowah himself, and he **will** answer me from his **holy mountain**. (**Psalms 3:4**)
- Who may ascend into the **mountain** of Yehowah, and who may rise up in his **holy** place? (**Psalms 24:3**)
- And many peoples **will** certainly go and say; Come, **you** people, and let us go up to the **mountain** of Yehowah, to the house of the God of Jacob, and he **will** instruct us about his ways, and we **will** walk in his paths. For out of Zion Law **will** go forth, and the word of Yehowah out of Jerusalem. (**Isaiah 2:3**)
- Then I put Shelemiah the priest and Zadok the copyist and Pedaiah of the Levites in charge of the stores, and under their control there was Hanan the son of Zaccur the son of Mattaniah, for they were considered faithful, and upon them it devolved to do the distributing to their brothers. (**Nehemiah 13:13**)
- For you are not a God taking delight in wickedness, no one bad may **reside** for any time with you. (**Psalms 5:4**)
- One thing I have asked from Yehowah, It is what I shall look for, that I may dwell in the house of Yehowah all the days of my life, to behold the pleasantness of Yehowah and to look with appreciation upon his temple. (**Psalms 27:4**)

- Happy is the one you choose and cause to approach, that he may **reside** in your courtyards. We **will** certainly be satisfied with the goodness of your house, the **holy** place of your temple. (**Psalms 65:4**)
- Your **tent** community, they have dwelt in it, with your goodness you proceeded to make it ready for the afflicted one, O God. (**Psalms 68:10**)
- You have ascended on high. You have carried away captives. You have taken gifts in the form of men, yes, even the stubborn ones, to **reside** among them, O Yah God. (**Psalms 68:18**)
- But if they had stood in my intimate group, then they would have made my people hear my own words, and they would have caused them to turn back from their bad way and from the badness of their dealings. (**Jeremiah 23:22**)
- For the men who minister in a fine manner are acquiring for themselves a fine standing and great freeness of speech in the faith in connection with Christ Jesus. (**1 Timothy 3:13**)
- Everyone remaining in union with him does not practice sin, no one that practices sin has either seen him or come to know him. (**1 John 3:6**)
- That is why they are before the throne of God, and they are rendering him sacred service day and night in his temple, and the One seated on the throne **will** spread his **tent** over them. (**Revelation 7:15**)
- And the temple sanctuary of God that is in heaven was opened, and the ark of his covenant was seen in his temple sanctuary. And there occurred lightnings and voices and thunders and an earthquake and a great hail. (**Revelation 11:19**)
