**Psalms 84:11** For Yehowah God is a sun and a shield, favor and glory are what he gives. Yehowah himself will not hold back anything good from those walking in faultlessness.

- **Yehowah** is my light and my salvation. Of whom shall I be in fear? **Yehowah** is the stronghold of my life. Of whom shall I be in dread? (**Psalms 27:1**)
- For you the **sun will** no more prove to be a light by day, and for brightness the moon itself **will** no more give you light. And **Yehowah** must become to you an indefinitely lasting light, and your **God** your beauty. (**Isaiah 60:19**)
- After these things the word of **Yehowah** came to Abram in a vision, saying; Do not fear, Abram. I am a **shield** for you. Your reward **will** be very great. (**Genesis 15:1**)
- Happy you are, O Israel! Who is there like you, a people enjoying salvation in **Yehowah**, the **shield** of your help, and the One who is your eminent sword? So your enemies **will** cringe before you, and you, upon their high places you **will** tread. (**Deuteronomy 33:29**)
- My **God** is my rock. I shall take refuge in him, my **shield** and my horn of salvation, my secure height, and my place for flight, my Savior, from violence you save me. (**2 Samuel 22:3**)
- And yet you, O **Yehowah**, are a **shield** about me, my **glory** and the One lifting up my head. (**Psalms 3:3**)
- O **shield** of ours, see, O **God**, and look upon the face of your anointed one. (**Psalms 84:9**)
- O Israel, trust in **Yehowah**, he is their help and their **shield**. (**Psalms 115:9**)

- You are my place of concealment and my **shield**. For your word I have waited. (**Psalms 119:114**)
- My loving-kindness and my stronghold, my secure height and my Provider of escape for me, my **shield** and the One in whom I have taken refuge, the One subduing peoples under me. (**Psalms 144:2**)
- And for the upright ones he **will** treasure up practical wisdom, for those **walking** in integrity he is a **shield**. (**Proverbs 2:7**)
- And all of us, while we with unveiled faces reflect like mirrors the **glory** of **Yehowah**, are transformed into the same image from **glory** to **glory**, exactly as done by **Yehowah** the Spirit. (**2 Corinthians 3:18**)
- There happened to be a man in the land of Uz whose name was Job, and that man proved to be blameless and upright, and fearing **God** and turning aside from bad. (**Job 1:1**)
- Fear **Yehowah**, **you** holy ones of his, for there is no lack to those fearing him. (**Psalms 34:9**)
- **Yehowah** is aware of the days of the faultless ones, and their very inheritance **will** continue even to time indefinite. (**Psalms 37:18**)
- So, if any one of **you** is lacking in wisdom, let him keep on asking **God**, for he **gives** generously to all and without reproaching, and it **will** be given him. (**James 1:5**)
- And I was willing to give you the house of your lord and the wives of your lord into your bosom, and to give you the house of Israel and of Judah. And if it were not enough, I was willing to add to you things like these as well as other things. (**2 Samuel 12:8**)
- And I shall prove myself faultless toward him, and I **will** keep myself from error on my part. (**2 Samuel 22:24**)
- And also **what** you have not requested I **will** give you, both riches and **glory**, so that there **will** not have happened to be any among the kings like you, all your days. (**1 Kings 3:13**)
- And **Yehowah** went on to say to Satan; Have you set your heart upon my servant Job, that there is no one like him in the earth, a man blameless and upright, fearing **God** and turning aside from bad? (**Job 1:8**)
- Have not you yourself put up a hedge about him and about his house and about everything that he has all around? The work of his

hands you have blessed, and his livestock itself has spread abroad in the earth. (**Job 1:10**)

- For you yourself **will** bless anyone righteous, O **Yehowah**, as with a large **shield**, with approval you **will** surround them. (**Psalms 5:12**)

- And I **will** prove myself faultless with him, and I shall keep myself from error on my part. (**Psalms 18:23**)

- As for the true **God**, perfect is his way, the saying of **Yehowah** is a refined one. A **shield** he is to all those taking refuge in him. (**Psalms 18:30**)

- **Yehowah** is my Shepherd. I shall lack nothing. (**Psalms 23:1**)

- **Yehowah** is my strength and my **shield**. In him my heart has trusted, and I have been helped, so that my heart exults, and with my song I shall laud him. (**Psalms 28:7**)

- The maned young lions themselves have had little on hand and gone hungry, but as for those seeking **Yehowah**, they **will** not lack **anything good**. (**Psalms 34:10**)

- **Yehowah** is redeeming the soul of his servants, and none of those taking refuge in him **will** be held guilty. (**Psalms 34:22**)

- Let those cry out joyfully and rejoice who are delighting in my righteousness, and let them say constantly; Let **Yehowah** be magnified, who takes delight in the peace of his servant. (**Psalms 35:27**)

- **God** is indeed **good** to Israel, to those clean in heart. (**Psalms 73:1**)

- Also, **Yehowah**, for his part, **will** give **what is good**, and our own land **will** give its yield. (**Psalms 85:12**)

- With his pinions he **will** block approach to you, and under his wings you **will** take refuge. His trueness **will** be a large **shield** and bulwark. (**Psalms 91:4**)

- **You** that fear **Yehowah**, trust in **Yehowah**, he is their help and their **shield**. (**Psalms 115:11**)

- For **Yehowah** is taking pleasure in his people. He beautifies the meek ones with salvation. (**Psalms 149:4**)

- He that is causing the upright ones to go astray into the bad way **will** himself fall into his own pit, but the faultless ones themselves **will** come into possession of **good**. (**Proverbs 28:10**)
- Every saying of **God** is refined. He is a **shield** to those taking refuge in him. (**Proverbs 30:5**)
- And Israel's Light must become a fire, and his Holy One a flame, and it must blaze up and eat up his weeds and his thornbushes in one day. (**Isaiah 10:17**)
- No more **will** your **sun** set, nor **will** your moon go on the wane, for **Yehowah** himself **will** become for you an indefinitely lasting light, and the days of your mourning **will** have come to completion. (**Isaiah 60:20**)
- Concerning this very salvation a diligent inquiry and a careful search were made by the prophets who prophesied about the undeserved kindness meant for **you**. (**1 Peter 1:10**)
- And I saw when he opened the sixth seal, and a great earthquake occurred, and the **sun** became black as sackcloth of hair, and the entire moon became as blood. (**Revelation 6:12**)
