Psalms 18:2· Yehowah is my crag and my stronghold and the Provider of escape for me. My God is my rock. I shall take refuge in him, my shield and my horn of salvation, my secure height.

- And yet you, O Yehowah, are a **shield** about me, my glory and the One lifting up my head. (**Psalms 3:3**)
- And Yehowah will help them and provide them with **escape**. He will provide them with **escape** from wicked people and save them, because they have taken **refuge** in him. (**Psalms 37:40**)
- But I am afflicted and poor. Yehowah himself **takes** account of me. You are my assistance and the **Provider** of **escape** for me. O my **God**, do not be too late. (**Psalms 40:17**)
- But I am afflicted and poor. O **God**, do act quickly for me. You are my help and the **Provider** of **escape** for me. O Yehowah, do not be too late. (**Psalms 70:5**)
- My loving-kindness and my **stronghold**, my **secure height** and my **Provider** of **escape** for me, my **shield** and the One in whom I have taken **refuge**, the One subduing peoples under me. (**Psalms 144:2**)
- The **God** of Israel said, to me the Rock of Israel spoke, when one ruling over mankind is righteous, ruling in the fear of **God**. (**2 Samuel 23:3**)
- **God** is for us a **refuge** and strength, a help that is readily to be found during distresses. (**Psalms 46:1**)
- After these things the word of Yehowah came to Abram in a vision, saying; Do not fear, Abram. I am a **shield** for you. Your reward will be very great. (**Genesis 15:1**)

- The Rock, perfect is his activity, for all his ways are justice. A **God** of faithfulness, with whom there is no injustice. Righteous and upright is he. (**Deuteronomy 32:4**)
- My **God** is my **rock**. I shall **take refuge** in him, my **shield** and my **horn of salvation**, my **secure height**, and my place for flight, my Savior, from violence you save me. (**2 Samuel 22:3**)
- And for the upright ones he will treasure up practical wisdom, for those walking in integrity he is a **shield**. (**Proverbs 2:7**)
- And he has raised up a **horn of salvation** for us in the house of David his servant. (**Luke 1:69**)
- And Hannah went on to pray and say; My heart does exult in Yehowah, my **horn** is indeed exalted in Yehowah. My mouth is widened against my enemies, for I do rejoice in the **salvation** from you. (**1 Samuel 2:1**)
- Consequently Saul sought to pin David to the wall with the spear, but he dodged from before Saul, so that he struck the spear into the wall. And David himself fled that he might **escape** during that night. (**1 Samuel 19:10**)
- At that Saul turned back from chasing after David and went to meet the Philistines. That is why they have called that place the Crag of the Divisions. (**1 Samuel 23:28**)
- And he went on to say; Yehowah is my **crag** and my **stronghold** and the **Provider** of **escape** for me. (**2 Samuel 22:2**)
- But he said; Do not be afraid, for there are more who are with us than those who are with them. (**2 Kings 6:16**)
- O Yehowah my **God**, in you I have taken **refuge**. Save me from all those persecuting me and deliver me. (**Psalms 7:1**)
- As for the true **God**, perfect is his way, the saying of Yehowah is a refined one. A **shield** he is to all those taking **refuge** in him. (**Psalms 18:30**)
- Let the sayings of my mouth and the meditation of my heart become pleasurable before you, O Yehowah my Rock and my Redeemer. (**Psalms 19:14**)
- In you, O Yehowah, have I taken **refuge**. O may I never be ashamed. In your righteousness provide **escape** for me. (**Psalms 31:1**)

- Incline to me your ear. Deliver me speedily. Become for me a rocky **stronghold**, a house of **strongholds** to save me. (**Psalms 31:2**)
- Our very soul has been in expectation of Yehowah. Our helper and our **shield** he is. (**Psalms 33:20**)
- Whatever day I get afraid, I, for my part, shall trust even in you. (**Psalms 56:3**)
- Show me favor, O **God**, show me favor, for in you my soul has taken **refuge**, and in the shadow of your wings I **take refuge** until the adversities pass over. (**Psalms 57:1**)
- For you have proved to be a **refuge** for me, a strong tower in the face of the enemy. (**Psalms 61:3**)
- Indeed he is my **rock** and my **salvation**, my **secure height**, I shall not be made to totter very much. (**Psalms 62:2**)
- Become to me a **rock** fortress into which to enter constantly. You must command to save me, for you are my **crag** and my **stronghold**. (**Psalms 71:3**)
- He himself calls out to me; You are my Father, my **God** and the Rock of my salvation. (**Psalms 89:26**)
- I will say to Yehowah; You are my **refuge** and my **stronghold**, my **God**, in whom I will trust. (**Psalms 91:2**)
- Because on me he has set his affection, I shall also provide him with **escape**. I shall protect him because he has come to know my name. (**Psalms 91:14**)
- To tell that Yehowah is upright. He is my Rock, in whom there is no unrighteousness. (**Psalms 92:15**)
- But Yehowah will become a **secure height** for me, and my **God** the **rock** of my **refuge**. (**Psalms 94:22**)
- Yah is my shelter and my might, and to me he becomes **salvation**. (**Psalms 118:14**)
- Blessed be Yehowah my Rock, who is teaching my hands for fighting, my fingers for warfare. (**Psalms 144:1**)
- The name of Yehowah is a strong tower. Into it the righteous runs and is given protection. (**Proverbs 18:10**)
- For you have forgotten the **God** of your **salvation**, and the Rock of your fortress you have not remembered. That is why you plant

pleasant plantations, and with the shoot of a stranger you set it.
(**Isaiah 17:10**)

· O Yehowah my strength and my **stronghold**, and my place for flight in the day of distress, to you the nations themselves will come from the ends of the earth, and they will say; Indeed our forefathers came to possess sheer falsehood, vanity and things in which there was nothing beneficial. (**Jeremiah 16:19**)
