- And the lamp of God was not yet extinguished, and Samuel was lying in the temple of Yehowah, where the ark of God was. (**1 Samuel 3:3**)
- Thus they brought the ark of the true God in and placed it inside the tent that David had pitched for it, and they began to present burnt offerings and communion sacrifices before the true God. (**1 Chronicles 16:1**)
- One thing I **have** asked from Yehowah. It is what I shall look for, that I may dwell in the **house** of Yehowah all the days of my life, to behold the pleasantness of Yehowah and to look with appreciation upon his temple. (**Psalms 27:4**)
- For a day in your courtyards is better than a thousand elsewhere. I **have** chosen to stand at the threshold in the **house** of my God rather than to move around in the tents of wickedness. (**Psalms 84:10**)
- And the priests were not able to stand to minister because of the cloud, for the **glory** of Yehowah filled the **house** of the true God. (**2 Chronicles 5:14**)
- Thus I **have** beheld you in the holy **place**, at seeing your strength and your **glory**. (**Psalms 63:2**)
- But the king said to Zadok; Take the ark of the true God back to the city. If I shall find favor in the eyes of Yehowah, he will also certainly bring me back and let me see it and its abiding **place**. (**2 Samuel 15:25**)
- And since I am taking pleasure in the **house** of my God, there is yet a special property of mine, gold and silver, I do give it to the **house**

of my God over and above all that I **have** prepared for the holy **house**.

- For the sake of the **house** of Yehowah our God I will keep seeking good for you. (**Psalms 122:9**)
