Isaiah 54:14· You will prove to be firmly established in righteousness itself. You will be far away from oppression, for you will fear none, and from anything terrifying, for it will not come near you.

- You **will** not be afraid of **anything** dreadful by night, nor of the arrow that flies by day. (**Psalms 91:5**)
- Nor of the pestilence that walks in the gloom, nor of the destruction that despoils at midday. (**Psalms 91:6**)
- A thousand **will** fall at your very side and ten thousand at your right hand, to you it **will** not **come near**. (**Psalms 91:7**)
- Only with your eyes **will** you look on and see the retribution itself of the wicked ones. (**Psalms 91:8**)
- Because you said; Yehowah is my refuge, you have made the Most High himself your dwelling. (**Psalms 91:9**)
- No calamity **will** befall you, and not even a plague **will** draw **near** to your tent. (**Psalms 91:10**)
- Because on me he has set his affection, I shall also provide him with escape. I shall protect him because he has **come** to know my name. (**Psalms 91:14**)
- He **will** call upon me, and I shall answer him. I shall be with him in distress. I shall rescue him and glorify him. (**Psalms 91:15**)

- The utterance of Yehowah to my Lord is; Sit at my right hand until I place your enemies as a stool for your feet. (**Psalms 110:1**)
