Psalms 30:3· O Yehowah, you have brought up my soul from Sheol itself, you have kept me alive, that I should not go down into the pit.

- For you will not leave my **soul** in **Sheol**. You will not allow your loyal one to see the **pit**. (**Psalms 16:10**)
- For your loving-kindness is great toward me, and you **have** delivered my **soul** out of **Sheol**, its lowest place. (**Psalms 86:13**)
- He saw beforehand and spoke concerning the resurrection of the Christ, that neither was he forsaken in Hades nor did his flesh see corruption. (**Acts of Apostles 2:31**)
- To you, O Yehowah, I keep calling. O my Rock, do not be deaf to me, that you may not keep still toward me And I do not **have** to become like those going **down** to the **pit**. (**Psalms 28:1**)
- Look! For peace I had what was bitter, yes, bitter, and you yourself **have** become attached to my **soul** and **kept** it from the **pit** of disintegration. For you **have** thrown behind your back all my sins. (**Isaiah 38:17**)
- To the bottoms of the mountains I went **down**. As for the earth, its bars were upon me for time indefinite. But out of the **pit** you proceeded to bring up my life, O Yehowah my God. (**Jonah 2:6**)
- Yehowah is a Killer and a Preserver of life, a Bringer **down** to **Sheol**, and He brings up. (**1 Samuel 2:6**)
- To the **pit** I shall **have** to call out, You are my father! To the maggot, My mother and my sister! (**Job 17:14**)
- Show me favor, O Yehowah, see my affliction by those hating me, O you who are lifting me up from the gates of death. (**Psalms 9:13**)

- However, God himself will redeem my **soul** from the hand of **Sheol**, for he will receive me. (**Psalms 49:15**)
- He proceeded to send his word and heal them and to provide them escape out of their **pits**. (**Psalms 107:20**)
- Let us swallow them **down alive** just like **Sheol**, even whole, like those going **down** into a **pit**. (**Proverbs 1:12**)
- The one stooping in chains will certainly be loosened speedily, that he may not **go** in death to the **pit** and that his bread may not be lacking. (**Isaiah 51:14**)
- From the hand of **Sheol** I shall redeem them, from death I shall recover them. Where are your stings, O Death? Where is your destructiveness, O **Sheol**? Compassion itself will be concealed from my eyes. (**Hosea 13:14**)
- Yes, indeed, he fell sick nearly to the point of death, but God had mercy on him, in fact, not only on him, but also on me, that I should not get grief upon grief. (**Philippians 2:27**)
