Psalms 31:11· From the standpoint of all those showing hostility to me I have become a reproach, and to my neighbors very much so, and a dread to my acquaintances. When seeing me out of doors, they have fled from me.

- From vexation my eye has **become** weak, it has grown old because of all those **showing hostility** to me. (**Psalms 6:7**)
- And **you** will be objects of hatred by all people on account of my name, but he that has endured to the end is the one that will be saved. (**Matthew 10:22**)
- Then people will deliver **you** up to tribulation and will kill **you**, and **you** will be objects of hatred by all the nations on account of my name. (**Matthew 24:9**)
- And **you** will be objects of hatred by all people because of my name. (**Luke 21:17**)
- But I am a worm, and not a man, a **reproach** to men and despicable to the people. (**Psalms 22:6**)
- With murder against my bones those **showing hostility** to me **have** reproached me, while they say to me all day long; Where is your God? (**Psalms 42:10**)
- All day long my enemies **have** reproached me. Those making a fool of me **have** sworn even by me. (**Psalms 102:8**)
- Truly our sicknesses were what he himself carried, and as for our pains, he bore them. But we ourselves accounted him as plagued, stricken by God and afflicted. (**Isaiah 53:4**)
- For even the Christ did not please himself, but just as it is written; The reproaches of those who were reproaching you **have** fallen upon me. (**Romans 15:3**)

- If **you** are being reproached for the name of Christ, **you** are happy, because the spirit of glory, even the spirit of God, is resting upon **you**. **(1 Peter 4:14)**
- My own brothers he has put far away from me, and the very ones knowing me **have** even turned aside from me. **(Job 19:13)**
- As for my lovers and my companions, they keep standing away from my plague, and my close **acquaintances** themselves **have** stood off at a distance. **(Psalms 38:11)**
- You **have** put my **acquaintances** far away from me, you **have** set me as something very detestable to them. I am under restraint and cannot go forth. **(Psalms 88:8)**
- But all this has taken place for the scriptures of the prophets to be fulfilled. Then all the disciples abandoned him and **fled**. **(Matthew 26:56)**
- In my first defense no one came to my side, but they all proceeded to forsake me, may it not be put to their account. **(2 Timothy 4:16)**
- And all the princes of the jurisdictional districts and the satraps and the governors and the doers of the business that belonged to the king were assisting the Jews, for the **dread** of Mordecai had fallen upon them. **(Esther 9:3)**
- I **have become** one estranged to my brothers, and a foreigner to the sons of my mother. **(Psalms 69:8)**
- You **have** put far away from me friend and companion, my **acquaintances** are a dark place. **(Psalms 88:18)**
- And to them I myself **have become** something reproachable. They see me, they begin wagging their head. **(Psalms 109:25)**
- Look to the right hand and see that there is no one giving any recognition to me. My place for flight has perished from me, there is no one inquiring for my soul. **(Psalms 142:4)**
