- Among the apostate mockers for a cake there was a grinding of their teeth even against me. (**Psalms 35:16**)
- Happy are **YOU** when people reproach **YOU** and persecute **YOU** and lyingly say every sort of wicked thing against **YOU** for my sake. (**Matthew 5:11**)
- Jesus began to say; Leave the place, for the little girl did not die, but she is sleeping. At this they began to laugh at him scornfully. (**Matthew 9:24**)
- Now the Pharisees, who were money lovers, were listening to all these things, and they began to sneer at him. (**Luke 16:14**)
- I myself also could well speak as **YOU** men do. If only **YOUR** souls existed where my soul is, would I be brilliant in words against **YOU**, and would I wag my **head** against **you**? (**Job 16:4**)
- You set us as a proverbial saying among the nations, a shaking of the **head** among the national groups. (**Psalms 44:14**)
- And to them I myself have become something reproachable. They see me, they begin **wagging** their **head**. (**Psalms 109:25**)
- So the passersby began speaking abusively of him, **wagging** their **heads** (**Matthew 27:39**)
- This is the word that Yehowah has spoken against him; The virgin daughter of Zion has despised you, she has held you in **derision**. Behind you the daughter of Jerusalem has wagged her **head**. (**2 Kings 19:21**)

- I too have a heart as well as **you**. I am not inferior to **you**, and with whom are there not things like these? (**Job 12:3**)
- Many are saying of my soul; There is no salvation for him by God. (**Psalms 3:2**)
- How long shall I set resistance in my soul, grief in my heart by day? How long will my enemy be exalted over me? (**Psalms 13:2**)
- This is the word that Yehowah has spoken against him; The virgin daughter of Zion has despised you, she has held you in **derision**. Behind you the daughter of Jerusalem has wagged her **head**. (**Isaiah 37:22**)
- You have fooled me, O Yehowah, so that I was fooled. You used your strength against me, so that you prevailed. I became an object of laughter all day long, everyone is holding me in **derision**. (**Jeremiah 20:7**)
- At you all those passing along on the road have clapped their hands. They have whistled and kept **wagging** their **head** at the daughter of Jerusalem, saying; Is this the city of which they used to say; It is the perfection of prettiness, an exultation for all the earth? (**Lamentations 2:15**)
- And those going by would speak abusively to him, **wagging** their **heads** and saying; Bah! You would-be thrower-down of the temple and builder of it in three days' time. (**Mark 15:29**)
- For instance, he will be delivered up to men of the nations and will be made fun of and be treated insolently and spit upon. (**Luke 18:32**)
- Now the men that had him in custody began to make fun of him, hitting him. (**Luke 22:63**)
- Then Herod together with his soldier guards discredited him, and he made fun of him by clothing him with a bright garment and sent him back to Pilate. (**Luke 23:11**)
- Even the soldiers made fun of him, coming close and offering him sour wine (**Luke 23:36**)
- Explaining and proving by references that it was necessary for the Christ to suffer and to rise from the dead, and saying; This is the Christ, this Jesus whom I am publishing to **you**. (**Acts of Apostles 17:3**)

- That the Christ was to suffer and, as the first to be resurrected from the dead, he was going to publish light both to this people and to the nations. (**Acts of Apostles 26:23**)
