- Jesus said to him; I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. **(John 14:6)**
- For this very reason also God exalted him to a superior position and kindly gave him the name that is above every other name. **(Philippians 2:9)**
- And whatever it is that **you** do in word or in work, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, thanking God the Father through him. **(Colossians 3:17)**
- The way of the wicked ones is like the gloom, they have not known at what they keep stumbling. **(Proverbs 4:19)**
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am laying as a foundation in Zion a **stone**, a tried **stone**, the precious corner of a sure foundation. No one exercising faith will get panicky. **(Isaiah 28:16)**
- Look! The Sovereign Lord Yehowah himself will help me. Who is there that can pronounce me wicked? Look! All of them, like a garment, will wear out. A mere moth will eat them up. **(Isaiah 50:9)**
- Therefore this is what Yehowah has said; Here I am setting for this people stumbling blocks, and they will certainly **stumble** over them, fathers and sons together, the neighbor and his companion, they will perish. **(Jeremiah 6:21)**
- For I myself, Yehowah, shall speak what word I shall speak, and it will be done. There will be no postponement anymore, for in **YOUR**

days, O rebellious house, I shall speak a word and certainly do it, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Ezekiel 12:25**)

- And happy is he that finds no cause for stumbling in me. (**Matthew 11:6**)
- Also, the person falling upon this **stone** will be shattered. As for anyone upon whom it falls, it will pulverize him. (**Matthew 21:44**)
- Also, Simeon blessed them, but said to Mary its mother; Look! This one is laid for the fall and the rising again of many in **Israel** and for a sign to be talked **against** (**Luke 2:34**)
- And happy is he who has not stumbled over me. (**Luke 7:23**)
- Everyone falling upon that **stone** will be shattered. As for anyone upon whom it falls, it will pulverize him. (**Luke 20:18**)
- As it is written; Look! I am laying in Zion a **stone** of stumbling and a rock-mass of offense, but he that rests his faith on it will not come to disappointment. (**Romans 9:33**)
- But we preach Christ impaled, to the Jews a cause for stumbling but to the nations foolishness. (**1 Corinthians 1:23**)
- And a **stone** of stumbling and a rock-mass of offense. These are stumbling because they are disobedient to the word. To this very end they were also appointed. (**1 Peter 2:8**)
