- Until upon us the **spirit** is poured **out** from on high, and the wilderness **will** have become an orchard, and the orchard itself is accounted as a real forest. **(Isaiah 32:15)**

I shall make them walk to torrent valleys of water, in a right way in which they **will** not be caused to stumble. For I have become to Israel a Father, and as for Ephraim, he is my firstborn. **(Jeremiah 31:9)**

- Next he said to Thomas; Put your finger here, and see my hands, and take your hand and stick it into my side, and stop being unbelieving but become believing. **(John 20:27)**
