Isaiah 62:2· And the nations will certainly see your righteousness, O woman, and all kings your glory. And you will actually be called by a new name, which the very mouth of Yehowah will designate.

- But I want **you** to know that the head of every man is the Christ, in turn the head of a **woman** is the man, in turn the head of the Christ is God. (**1 Corinthians 11:3**)
- In the beginning the Word was, and the Word was with God, and the Word was a god. (**John 1:1**)
- This one was in the beginning with God. (**John 1:2**)
- He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn of all creation. (**Colossians 1:15**)
- Because by means of him all other things were created in the heavens and upon the earth, the things visible and the things invisible, no matter whether they are thrones or lordships or governments or authorities. All other things have been created through him and for him. (**Colossians 1:16**)
- Also, he is before all other things and by means of him all other things were made to exist. (**Colossians 1:17**)
- And he is the head of the body, the congregation. He is the beginning, the firstborn from the dead, that he might become the one who is first in all things. (**Colossians 1:18**)
- And a great sign was seen in heaven, a **woman** arrayed with the sun, and the moon was beneath her feet, and on her head was a crown of twelve stars. (**Revelation 12:1**)
- And she was pregnant. And she cries out in her pains and in her agony to give birth. (**Revelation 12:2**)

· And I shall put enmity between you and the **woman** and between your seed and her seed. He **will** bruise you in the head and you **will** bruise him in the heel. (**Genesis 3:15**)

· And to them the principal court official went assigning **names**. So he assigned to Daniel the **name** of Belteshazzar, and to Hananiah, Shadrach, and to Mishael, Meshach, and to Azariah, Abednego. (**Daniel 1:7**)

· Let the one who has an ear hear what the spirit says to the congregations; To him that conquers I **will** give some of the hidden manna, and I **will** give him a white pebble, and upon the pebble a **new name** written which no one knows except the one receiving it. (**Revelation 2:17**)

· His eyes are a fiery flame, and upon his head are many diadems. He has a **name** written that no one knows but he himself. (**Revelation 19:12**)

· Be collected together, all **you** people, and hear. Who among them has told these things? **Yehowah** himself has loved him. He **will** do what is his delight upon Babylon, and his own arm **will** be upon the Chaldeans. (**Isaiah 48:14**)

· Cry out joyfully, you barren **woman** that did not give birth! Become cheerful with a joyful outcry and cry shrilly, you that had no childbirth pains, for the sons of the desolated one are more numerous than the sons of the **woman** with a husbandly owner, **Yehowah** has said. (**Isaiah 54:1**)

· You **will** prove to be firmly established in **righteousness** itself. You **will** be far away from oppression, for you **will** fear none, and from anything terrifying, for it **will** not come near you. (**Isaiah 54:14**)

· And **kings** must become caretakers for you, and their princesses nursing women for you. With faces to the earth they **will** bow down to you, and the dust of your feet they **will** lick up, and you **will** have to know that I am **Yehowah**, of whom those hoping in me **will** not be ashamed. (**Isaiah 49:23**)

· Arise, O **woman**, shed forth light, for your light has come and upon you the very **glory** of **Yehowah** has shone forth. (**Isaiah 60:1**)

· And your gates **will actually** be kept open constantly, they **will** not be closed even by day or by night, in order to bring to you the resources of the nations, and their **kings will** be taking the lead. (**Isaiah 60:11**)

- And **you** men **will certainly** lay up **your name** for an oath by my chosen ones, and the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah will actually** put **you** individually to death, but his own servants he **will** call by another **name**. (**Isaiah 65:15**)
- And when that one arrives he **will** give the world convincing evidence concerning sin and concerning **righteousness** and concerning judgment. (**John 16:8**)
- The **kings** of Tarshish and of the islands, tribute they **will** pay. The **kings** of Sheba and of Seba, a gift they **will** present. (**Psalms 72:10**)
- In those days Judah **will** be saved and Jerusalem itself **will** reside in security. And this is what she **will** be **called**, **Yehowah Is Our Righteousness**. (**Jeremiah 33:16**)
- **Yehowah** has made his salvation known, in the eyes of the nations he has revealed his **righteousness**. (**Psalms 98:2**)
- This one **will** say; I belong to Yehowah. And that one **will** call himself by the **name** of Jacob, and another **will** write upon his hand; Belonging to Yehowah. And by the **name** of Israel one **will** betitle himself. (**Isaiah 44:5**)
