- And you must love Yehowah your God with all your heart and all your soul and all your vital force. (**Deuteronomy 6:5**)
- And you must love Yehowah your God with your whole heart and with your whole soul and with your whole mind and with your whole strength. (**Mark 12:30**)
- As for us, we love, because he first loved us. (**1 John 4:19**)
- Yehowah is my crag and my stronghold and the Provider of **escape** for me. My God is my rock. I shall take refuge in him, my shield and my horn of salvation, my secure height. (**Psalms 18:2**)
- And those knowing your **name** will trust in you, for you will certainly not leave those looking for you, O Yehowah. (**Psalms 9:10**)
- The **name** of Yehowah is a strong tower. Into it the righteous runs and is given protection. (**Proverbs 18:10**)
- Therefore here I am causing them to **know**, at this one time I shall cause them to **know** my hand and my mightiness, and they will have to **know** that my **name** is Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 16:21**)
- This means everlasting life, their taking in knowledge of you, the only true God, and of the one whom you sent forth, Jesus Christ. (**John 17:3**)
- After that Yehowah said to Noah; Go, you and all your household, into the ark, because you are the one I have seen to be righteous before me among this generation. (**Genesis 7:1**)

- Blessed will you be when you **come** in, and blessed will you be when you go out. (**Deuteronomy 28:6**)
- Thus let all your enemies perish, O Yehowah, and let your lovers be as when the sun goes forth in its mightiness. And the land had no further disturbance for forty years. (**Judges 5:31**)
- That is why the utterance of Yehowah the God of Israel is; I did indeed say, As for your house and the house of your forefather, they will walk before me to time indefinite. But now the utterance of Yehowah is; It is unthinkable, on my part, because those honoring me I shall honor, and those despising me will be of little account. (**1 Samuel 2:30**)
- He committed himself to Yehowah. Let Him **provide** him with **escape**! Let him deliver him, since he **has** taken delight in him! (**Psalms 22:8**)
- Deliver me from my enemies, O my God, from those rising up against me may you **protect** me. (**Psalms 59:1**)
- And the offspring of his servants themselves will inherit it, and those loving his **name** will be the ones to reside in it. (**Psalms 69:36**)
- Precious in the eyes of Yehowah is the death of his loyal ones. (**Psalms 116:15**)
- For Yehowah himself will prove to be, in effect, your confidence, and he will certainly keep your foot against capture. (**Proverbs 3:26**)
- Those loving me I myself love, and those looking for me are the ones that find me. (**Proverbs 8:17**)
- But let the one bragging about himself brag about himself because of this very thing, the having of insight and the having of knowledge of me, that I am Yehowah, the One exercising loving-kindness, justice and righteousness in the earth, for in these things I do take delight, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 9:24**)
- And I will deliver you in that day, is the utterance of Yehowah, and you will not be given into the hand of the men of whom you yourself are scared. (**Jeremiah 39:17**)
- Nebuchadnezzar was answering and saying; Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego, who sent his angel and rescued his servants that trusted in him and that changed the very word of the king and gave over their bodies, because they would not serve and would not worship any god at all except their own God. (**Daniel 3:28**)

- **Accordingly the king himself commanded, and they brought Daniel and threw him into the pit of the lions. The king was answering and saying to Daniel; Your God whom you are serving with constancy, he himself will rescue you. (Daniel 6:16)**
