- They looked to him and became radiant, and their very faces could not possibly be ashamed. (Psalms 34:5)
- Look! As the eyes of servants are toward the hand of their master, as the eyes of a maidservant are toward the hand of her mistress, so our eyes are toward Yehowah our God until he shows us favor. (Psalms 123:2)
- And I will keep in expectation of Yehowah, who is concealing his face from the house of Jacob, and I will hope in him. (Isaiah 8:17)
- I shall indeed wait for salvation from you, O Yehowah. (Genesis 49:18)
- Make me walk in your truth and teach me, for you are my God of salvation. In you I have hoped all day long. (Psalms 25:5)
- Indeed toward God is my soul waiting in silence. From him my salvation is. (Psalms 62:1)
- Good it is that one should wait, even silently, for the salvation of Yehowah. (Lamentations 3:26)
- And, look! There was a man in Jerusalem named Simeon, and this man was righteous and reverent, waiting for Israel's consolation, and Holy Spirit was upon him. (Luke 2:25)
- So take knowledge that Yehowah will certainly distinguish his loyal one, Yehowah himself will hear when I call to him. (Psalms 4:3)
- I earnestly hoped in Yehowah, and so he inclined his ear to me and heard my cry for help. (Psalms 40:1)

- O Hearer of prayer, even to you people of all flesh **will** come. **(Psalms 65:2)**
- Look! **God** is my **salvation**. I shall trust and be in no dread, for Yah, Yehowah is my strength and my might, and he came to be the **salvation** of me. **(Isaiah 12:2)**

- Let your loving-kindness, O Yehowah, prove to be upon us, even as we have kept **waiting** for you. Of David, at the time of his disguising his sanity before Abimelech, so that he drove him out, and he went away. **(Psalms 33:22)**
- Why are you in despair, O my soul, and why are you boisterous within me? Wait for **God**, for I shall yet laud him as the grand **salvation** of my person. **(Psalms 42:5)**
- Indeed toward **God** wait silently, O my soul, because from him is my hope. **(Psalms 62:5)**
- For your **salvation** my soul has pined away, for your word I have waited. **(Psalms 119:81)**
- My soul has waited for Yehowah more than watchmen for the morning, watching for the morning. **(Psalms 130:6)**
- Let Israel wait for Yehowah from now on and to time indefinite. **(Psalms 131:3)**
- In that day earthling man **will** look up to his Maker, and his own eyes **will** gaze at the Holy One of Israel himself. **(Isaiah 17:7)**

- Yes, for the path of your judgments, O Yehowah, we have hoped in you. For your name and for your memorial the desire of the soul has been. (**Isaiah 26:8**)
- Turn to me and be saved, all **you** at the ends of the earth, for I am **God**, and there is no one else. (**Isaiah 45:22**)
- And from time long ago none have heard, nor have any given ear, nor has an eye itself seen a **God**, except you, that acts for the one that **keeps** in expectation of him. (**Isaiah 64:4**)

- If it is to be, our **God** whom we are serving is able to rescue us. Out of the burning fiery furnace and out of your hand, O king, he **will** rescue us. (**Daniel 3:17**)
- My **God will** reject them, for they have not listened to him, and they **will** become fugitives among the nations. (**Hosea 9:17**)
- To you, O Yehowah, I shall call, for fire itself has devoured the pasture grounds of the wilderness, and a very flame has consumed all the trees of the field. (**Joel 1:19**)
