- Listen, O **sons**, to the discipline of a father and pay attention, so as to know understanding. (**Proverbs 4:1**)
- And he went on to say to man; Look! The **fear** of **Yehowah**, that is wisdom, and to turn away from bad is understanding. (**Job 28:28**)
- The **fear** of **Yehowah** is the beginning of wisdom. All those doing them have a good insight. His praise is standing forever. (**Psalms 111:10**)

- **You** must also **teach** them to **YOUR sons**, so as to speak of them when you sit in your house and when you walk on the road and when you lie down and when you get up. (**Deuteronomy 11:19**)
- Congregate the people, the men and the women and the little ones and your alien resident who is within your gates, in order, that they may **listen** and in order, that they may learn, as they must **fear Yehowah YOUR** God and take care to carry out all the words of this Law. (**Deuteronomy 31:12**)
- As for me also, it is unthinkable, on my part, to sin against **Yehowah** by ceasing to pray in **YOUR** behalf, and I must instruct **YOU** in the good and right way. (**1 Samuel 12:23**)
- If there are none, you yourself **listen** to me, keep silent, and I shall **teach** you wisdom. (**Job 33:33**)
