- Do arise, O **Yehowah**! Save me, O my God! For you will **have** to strike all my enemies on the jaw. The teeth of wicked ones you will **have** to break. **(Psalms 3:7)**
- Let God arise, let his enemies be scattered, and let those who intensely hate him flee because of him. **(Psalms 68:1)**
- Who is there knowing the strength of your **anger** and your **fury** according to the fear of you? **(Psalms 90:11)**
- Do conduct my case, O **Yehowah**, against my opponents, war against those warring against me. **(Psalms 35:1)**
- Raise yourself up, O Judge of the earth. Bring back a retribution upon the haughty ones. **(Psalms 94:2)**
- Now I will rise up, says **Yehowah**, now I will exalt myself, now I will **lift** myself up. **(Isaiah 33:10)**
- Do arouse yourself. Why do you keep sleeping, O **Yehowah**? Do **awake**. Do not keep casting off forever. **(Psalms 44:23)**
- Like a dream after awaking, O **Yehowah**, so when arousing yourself you will despise their very image. **(Psalms 73:20)**
- Awake, **awake**, clothe yourself with strength, O arm of **Yehowah**! Awake as in the days of long ago, as during the generations of times long past. Are you not the one that broke Rahab to pieces, that pierced the sea monster? **(Isaiah 51:9)**

- When God rose up to **judgment**, to save all the meek of the earth. (**Psalms 76:9**)
- **Yehowah** is executing acts of righteousness and judicial decisions for all those being defrauded. (**Psalms 103:6**)
- Then David went out before them and answered and said to them; If it is for peace that **you have** come to me to help me, my own heart will become at unity with **you**. But if it is to betray me to my adversaries when there is no wrong on my palms, let the God of our forefathers see to it and set it in order. (**1 Chronicles 12:17**)
- O our God, will you not execute **judgment** upon them? For in us there is no power before this large crowd that is coming against us, and we ourselves do not know what we ought to do, but our eyes are toward you. (**2 Chronicles 20:12**)
- Harbona, one of the court officials before the king, now said; Also, there is the stake that Haman made for Mordecai, who had spoken good concerning the king, standing in Haman's house, fifty cubits high. At that the king said; **you** men, hang him on it. (**Esther 7:9**)
- Do rise up, O **Yehowah**, do confront him to the face, make him bow down, do provide escape for my soul from the wicked one with your sword. (**Psalms 17:13**)
- How many are the days of your servant? When will you execute **judgment** against those persecuting me? (**Psalms 119:84**)
- And people will enter into the caves of the rocks and into the holes of the dust because of the dreadfulness of **Yehowah** and from his splendid superiority, when he rises up for the earth to suffer shocks. (**Isaiah 2:19**)
