- While he was sitting upon the Mount of Olives, the disciples approached him privately, saying; Tell us; When will these things be, and what will be the sign of your presence and of the conclusion of the system of things? **(Matthew 24:3)**
- And in answer Jesus said to them; Look out that nobody misleads **YOU**. **(Matthew 24:4)**
- For many will come on the basis of my name, saying; I am the Christ, and will mislead many. **(Matthew 24:5)**
- **YOU** are going to hear of wars and reports of wars, see that **YOU** are not terrified. For these things must take place, but the end is not yet. **(Matthew 24:6)**
- For nation will rise against nation and kingdom against kingdom, and there will be food shortages and earthquakes in one place after another. **(Matthew 24:7)**
- All these things are a beginning of pangs of distress. **(Matthew 24:8)**
- Then people will deliver **YOU** up to tribulation and will kill **YOU**, and **YOU** will be objects of hatred by all the nations on account of my name. **(Matthew 24:9)**
- Then, also, many will be stumbled and will betray one another and will hate one another. **(Matthew 24:10)**
- And many false prophets will arise and mislead many. **(Matthew 24:11)**

- And because of the increasing of Lawlessness the love of the greater number will cool off. (**Matthew 24:12**)
- But he that has endured to the end is the one that will be saved. (**Matthew 24:13**)
- And this Good News of the kingdom will be preached in all the inhabited earth for a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come. (**Matthew 24:14**)
- See, **YOU** people, among the nations, and look on, and stare in amazement at one another. Be amazed, for there is an activity that one is carrying on in **YOUR** days, which **YOU** people will not believe although it is related. (**Habakkuk 1:5**)
- So the runners continued on, passing along from city to city throughout the **land** of Ephraim and Manasseh, **even** to Zebulun, but they were continually speaking in mockery of them and deriding them. (**2 Chronicles 30:10**)
- But they were continually making jest at the messengers of the true God and despising his words and mocking at his prophets, until the rage of **Yehowah** came up against his people, until there was no healing. (**2 Chronicles 36:16**)
- You **have** fooled me, O **Yehowah**, so that I was fooled. You used your strength against me, so that you prevailed. I became an object of laughter all day long, everyone is holding me in derision. (**Jeremiah 20:7**)
- For as often as I speak, I cry out. Violence and despoiling are what I call out. For the word of **Yehowah** became for me a cause for reproach and for jeering all day long. (**Jeremiah 20:8**)
- Because an exterminating and a strict decision the **Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies**, will be executing in the midst of the whole **land**. (**Isaiah 10:23**)
- Look! **Yehowah** is emptying the **land** and laying it waste, and he has twisted the face of it and scattered its inhabitants. (**Isaiah 24:1**)
- And the king himself had appointed the adjutant upon whose hand he was supporting himself to **have** charge of the gateway, and the people kept trampling him in the gateway, so that he died, just as the man of the true God had spoken, when he spoke at the time that the king came down to him. (**2 Kings 7:17**)

- If you **have** become wise, you **have** become wise in your own behalf, and if you **have** ridiculed, you will bear it, just you alone. (**Proverbs 9:12**)
- For although your people, O Israel, would prove to be like the grains of sand of the sea, a mere remnant among them will return. An **extermination decided** upon will be flooding through in righteousness. (**Isaiah 10:22**)
- Therefore say to them; This is what the **Sovereign Lord Yehowah** has said; I shall certainly cause this proverbial saying to cease, and they will no more say it as a proverb in Israel. But speak to them; The days **have** drawn near, and the matter of every vision. (**Ezekiel 12:23**)
- For an **extermination** has been made, and what of it if it is rejecting also the scepter? This will not continue existing, is the utterance of the **Sovereign Lord Yehowah**. (**Ezekiel 21:13**)
