Psalms 102:2· Do not conceal your face from me on the day that I am in sore straits. Incline to me your ear, on the day that I call, hurry, answer me.

- When he himself causes quietness, who, then, can condemn? And when he **conceals** his **face**, who can behold him, whether it is toward a nation or toward a man, it being the same thing? **(Job 34:29)**
- How long, O Yehowah, will you forget me? Forever? How long will you conceal your **face** from me? **(Psalms 13:1)**
- Do not conceal your **face** from me. Do not in anger turn your servant away. My assistance you must become. Do not forsake me and do not leave me, O my God of salvation. **(Psalms 27:9)**
- And do not conceal your **face** from your servant. Because I **am** in **sore straits**, **answer** me quickly. **(Psalms 69:17)**
- Why is it, O Yehowah, that you cast off my soul? Why do you keep your **face** concealed from me? **(Psalms 88:14)**
- See, O Yehowah, for I **am** in **sore straits**. My very intestines are in a ferment. My heart has been overturned in the midst of me, for I have been absolutely rebellious. Outside the sword caused bereavement of children. Within the house it is the same as death. **(Lamentations 1:20)**
- In your righteousness may you deliver me and provide me with escape. **Incline** to me your **ear** and save me. **(Psalms 71:2)**
- Before you my prayer will come. **Incline** your **ear** to my entreating cry. **(Psalms 88:2)**
- O **hurry**, **answer** me, O Yehowah. My spirit has come to an end. Do not conceal your **face** from me, or else I must become comparable with those going down into the pit. **(Psalms 143:7)**

- And it will actually occur that before they **call** out I myself shall **answer**, while they are yet speaking, I myself shall hear. (**Isaiah 65:24**)
- And Moses went to relating to his father-in-law all that Yehowah had done to Pharaoh and Egypt on account of Israel, and all the hardship that had befallen them in the way, and yet Yehowah was delivering them. (**Exodus 18:8**)
- My eyes have pined away for your saying, while I say; When will you comfort me? (**Psalms 119:82**)
- Also, when I **call** for aid and cry for help, he actually hampers my prayer. (**Lamentations 3:8**)
