Psalms 141:4 Do not incline my heart to anything bad, so as to carry on notorious deeds in wickedness with men who are practicing what is hurtful, that I may not feed myself on their dainties.

- So as to incline our **heart** to himself to walk in all his ways and to keep his commandments and his regulations and his judicial decisions, which he gave in command to our forefathers. (**1 Kings 8:58**)
- Incline my **heart** to your reminders, and not to profits. (**Psalms 119:36**)
- A king's **heart** is as streams of water in the hand of Yehowah. Everywhere that he delights to, he turns it. (**Proverbs 21:1**)
- And as regards these two kings, their **heart** will be inclined to doing **what is bad**, and at one table a lie is **what** they will keep speaking. But nothing will succeed, because the end is yet for the time appointed. (**Daniel 11:27**)
- Do not be misled! Bad associations spoil useful habits. (**1 Corinthians 15:33**)
- Do not **feed** yourself with the food of anyone of ungenerous eye, nor show yourself craving his tasty dishes. (**Proverbs 23:6**)
- And here he is charging her with **notorious deeds**, saying; I have found your daughter does not have evidence of virginity. Now this is the evidence of my daughter's virginity. And they must spread out the mantle before the older **men** of the city. (**Deuteronomy 22:17**)
- For that is the way he commanded me by the word of Yehowah, saying; You must not eat bread or drink water, and you must not return by the way that you went. (**1 Kings 13:9**)
- So years later he went down to Ahab at Samaria, and Ahab proceeded to sacrifice sheep and cattle in abundance for him and for

the people that were with him. And he began to allure him to go up against Ramoth-gilead. (**2 Chronicles 18:2**)
