- With my voice I shall call to Yehowah himself, and he will answer me from his holy mountain. (**Psalms 3:4**)
- You yourself are my **King**, O **God**. Command grand salvation for Jacob. (**Psalms 44:4**)
- And yet **God** is my **King** from long ago, the One performing grand salvation in the midst of the earth. (**Psalms 74:12**)
- I will exalt you, O my **God** the **King**, and I will bless your name to time indefinite, even forever. (**Psalms 145:1**)
- For Yehowah is our Judge, Yehowah is our Statute-giver, Yehowah is our **King**, he himself will save us. (**Isaiah 33:22**)
- O Hearer of prayer, even to you people of all flesh will come. (**Psalms 65:2**)
- **You** must **pray**, then, this way; Our Father in the heavens, let your name be sanctified. (**Matthew 6:9**)
- And Yehowah went on to say to him; I have heard your prayer and your request for favor with which you requested favor before me. I have sanctified this house that you have built by putting my name there to time indefinite, and my eyes and my heart will certainly prove to be there always. (**1 Kings 9:3**)
- And you must turn toward the prayer of your servant and to his request for favor, O Yehowah my **God**, by listening to the entreating **cry** and to the prayer with which your servant is praying before you. (**2 Chronicles 6:19**)

- In those days Hezekiah fell sick to the point of dying, and he began to **pray** to Yehowah. So He talked to him, and a portent He gave him. (**2 Chronicles 32:24**)
- Do hear what is righteous, O Yehowah, do pay **attention** to my entreating **cry**, do give ear to my prayer without lips of deception. (**Psalms 17:1**)
- Hear, O Yehowah, when I call with my voice, and show me favor and answer me. (**Psalms 27:7**)
- Do hear, O **God**, my entreating **cry**. Do pay **attention** to my prayer. (**Psalms 61:1**)
- O Yehowah, do hear my prayer, and to you may my own **cry** for **help** come. (**Psalms 102:1**)
